Introduction: • A Hook

- Author's Summary (be sure to include title & author, the author's thesis and 2 or 3 main points)
- Your Thesis

Body:

- 1. Introduce a relevant point from the passage to which you want to respond (this should be one of the main points identified above)
- 2. Include a quotation from the passage which conveys this idea
- 3. What is your response to this idea?
- 4. Include at least one example from your own knowledge, reading or experience:
- 5. Relate this idea back to your thesis

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III: Conclusion:

- Restate your thesis statement:
- Explain how your behavior will change as a result of your new knowledge or how you (or others) can use this
