## Coordination and Parallel Structure

## **GRAMMAR FOCUS**

By using coordination, a writer gives equal importance to two or more ideas within a sentence. Coordinating conjunctions are used to join two or more similar grammatical structures such as words, phrases, or clauses. Different coordinating conjunctions show the relationship between the parts of a sentence. In the following example, notice how the conjunction *but* joins two independent clauses and at the same time shows the contrast between them.

Engineers need excellent math skills, but they need good verbal skills, too.

Parallel structure means that the words, phrases, or clauses that are joined by coordinating conjunctions are the same grammatical structure. The following example uses the coordinating conjunction and to join the three parallel adjectives.

Undergraduate engineering majors must demonstrate their excellent math, verbal, and writing skills during interviews for professional positions.

This chapter will help you select the appropriate coordinating conjunction for the meaning you wish to convey, place the conjunction within the sentence correctly. and use parallel structure.
