Cool and very rainy western part and very rainy western part and a larger zone to the east that has desert-like conditions with hot summers, very cold winters.

Columbia Valley has sand soils created by the Missoula Floods and result in wines with increased aromatics.

Characteristics of grapes in this AVA

Nearly 60% of the region's vineyards are dedicated to full-bodied red wine varieties with Cabernet Sauvignon representing the state's top grape. (Plush, Fruity flavors paired with sweet-fat acidity and balanced tannins, makes Columbia Valley red wine unique).

- (AVA) areas: Yakima Valley, Red Mountain, Walla Walla Valley, Horse Heaven Hills, Rattlesnake Hills and Wahluke slope.
- The Columbia George and Puget Sound AVAs are the only appellations in Washington that fall outside of its borders.
