~CULTURAL AND SOCIAL NORMS:
SOCIETAL NORMS AND CULTURAL
PRACTICES PLAY A SIGNIFICANT ROLE
IN PERPETUATING GENDER
INEQUALITY. THESE NORMS MAY
DICTATE TRADITIONAL GENDER ROLES
AND REINFORCE THE IDEA THAT MEN
ARE MORE VALUABLE THAN WOMEN.

~DISCRIMINATORY LAWS AND POLICIES: LAWS AND POLICIES THAT DISCRIMINATE AGAINST WOMEN, SUCH AS LIMITATIONS ON THEIR ACCESS TO EDUCATION, EMPLOYMENT, AND PROPERTY OWNERSHIP, CAN CONTRIBUTE TO GENDER INEQUALITY.

~ BIASES AND STEREOTYPES: BIASES AND STEREOTYPES ABOUT GENDER ROLES AND CAPABILITIES CAN LIMIT OPPORTUNITIES FOR WOMEN AND REINFORCE GENDER INEQUALITY.

What will happen if Gender inequality gets worse

- → STUNTED ECONOMIC GROWTH:

 GENDER INEQUALITY CAN LIMIT

 ECONOMIC GROWTH BY REDUCING

 THE PARTICIPATION OF WOMEN IN

 THE WORKFORCE AND LIMITING

 THEIR ACCESS TO EDUCATION AND

 OPPORTUNITIES. THIS CAN

 ULTIMATELY HURT THE ECONOMY AS

 A WHOLE.
- → INCREASED VIOLENCE: GENDER
 INEQUALITY CAN CONTRIBUTE TO
 GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE,
 INCLUDING SEXUAL HARASSMENT,
 DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, AND HUMAN
 TRAFFICKING.
- → HEALTH PROBLEMS: GENDER
 INEQUALITY CAN ALSO HAVE
 NEGATIVE EFFECTS ON HEALTH
 OUTCOMES FOR WOMEN, AS THEY
 MAY HAVE LIMITED ACCESS TO
 HEALTHCARE, NUTRITION, AND
 REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH SERVICES.

How can you help?

ENDING GENDER INEQUALITY IS A COMPLEX AND ONGOING PROCESS THAT REQUIRES THE PARTICIPATION OF INDIVIDUALS, ORGANIZATIONS, AND GOVERNMENTS AT ALL LEVELS. HERE ARE SOME STEPS THAT CAN BE TAKEN TO PROMOTE GENDER EQUALITY:

- * RAISE AWARENESS: RAISING AWARENESS ABOUT THE ISSUE OF GENDER INEQUALITY IS ESSENTIAL FOR PROMOTING CHANGE. THIS CAN INCLUDE PUBLIC EDUCATION CAMPAIGNS, MEDIA COVERAGE, AND COMMUNITY EVENTS THAT HIGHLIGHT THE IMPORTANCE OF GENDER EQUALITY.
- ADDRESS GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE: ADDRESSING
 GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE IS ESSENTIAL FOR PROMOTING
 GENDER EQUALITY. THIS INCLUDES STRENGTHENING LAWS
 AND POLICIES RELATED TO SEXUAL HARASSMENT, DOMESTIC
 VIOLENCE, AND SEXUAL ASSAULT, AS WELL AS PROVIDING
 SUPPORT SERVICES FOR SURVIVORS.
- ADDRESS DISCRIMINATORY LAWS AND POLICIES: GOVERNMENTS CAN PLAY A KEY ROLE IN PROMOTING GENDER EQUALITY BY REVIEWING AND CHANGING LAWS AND POLICIES THAT DISCRIMINATE AGAINST WOMEN. THIS INCLUDES POLICIES RELATED TO ACCESS TO EDUCATION, HEALTHCARE, EMPLOYMENT, AND PROPERTY OWNERSHIP.
