It represents playfulness, gentleness, as well as still being authentic, resembling old writing. Something I've admired since I was a little girl. According to ITC (2017):

“In 1994, Edward Benguiat designed ITC Edwardian Script, an emotional, lyrical, even passionate calligraphic typeface. Its appearance was influenced by the look of writing with a steel pointed pen, an instrument which can be pushed as well as pulled, and which produces stroke contrast when pressure upon it is varied. The delicate, sophisticated letterforms of ITC Edwardian Script font were drawn and redrawn until the connective elements of the letters were perfected to create the look of true handwriting” (ITC, n.d).

The stars that separate my initials from one another represent the five letters in my first name. It also represents how I want to stand out and be unapologetically myself at all times. The color forest green that was chosen not only represents my favorite color, but it is: “...reminiscent

of various greeneries in nature. This versatile hue is associated with freshness, growth and balance. Because it is associated with the environment, the color Forest Green is frequently used in designs that support the earth and its ecosystem” (Designs, n.d).
