- (4) Health Disparities
 - The heart disease rate is more than 10% higher in Northwest Brooklyn than in NYC overall. 25% of adults were told by a health care professional that they have high blood pressure and 24% were told they have high cholesterol.
 - Adults in Northwest Brooklyn are more likely to binge drink than in NYC overall, and white residents and men are more likely to binge drink than other residents in this community. Those in Northwest Brooklyn have a 20% rate of binge drinking while New York City and Brooklyn have a 14% and 12% rate of binge drinking.
 - Although women here are more likely to get Pap tests for cervical cancer than women in NYC overall, they are getting mammograms for breast cancer at a rate below the TCNY target of 85%.

 - The B57 bus runs from Carroll Gardens to Maspeth Queens. On weekdays it comes every 15-20 minutes and there are bus stops at about every 2-3 blocks. The bus stops are easily accessible to community members who would need to walk to Court Street to get access to them. They are wheelchair friendly and some stations provide seating for commuters to wait for the bus.

- The F train runs from Queens to Coney Island with stops at Bergen and Carroll Street conveintely located nearby for residents. The F and G train both stop in the same station and is located on Smith and President Street right next to the park. Trains run every 4-6 minutes during rush hours and 6-8 minutes at slower hours.
