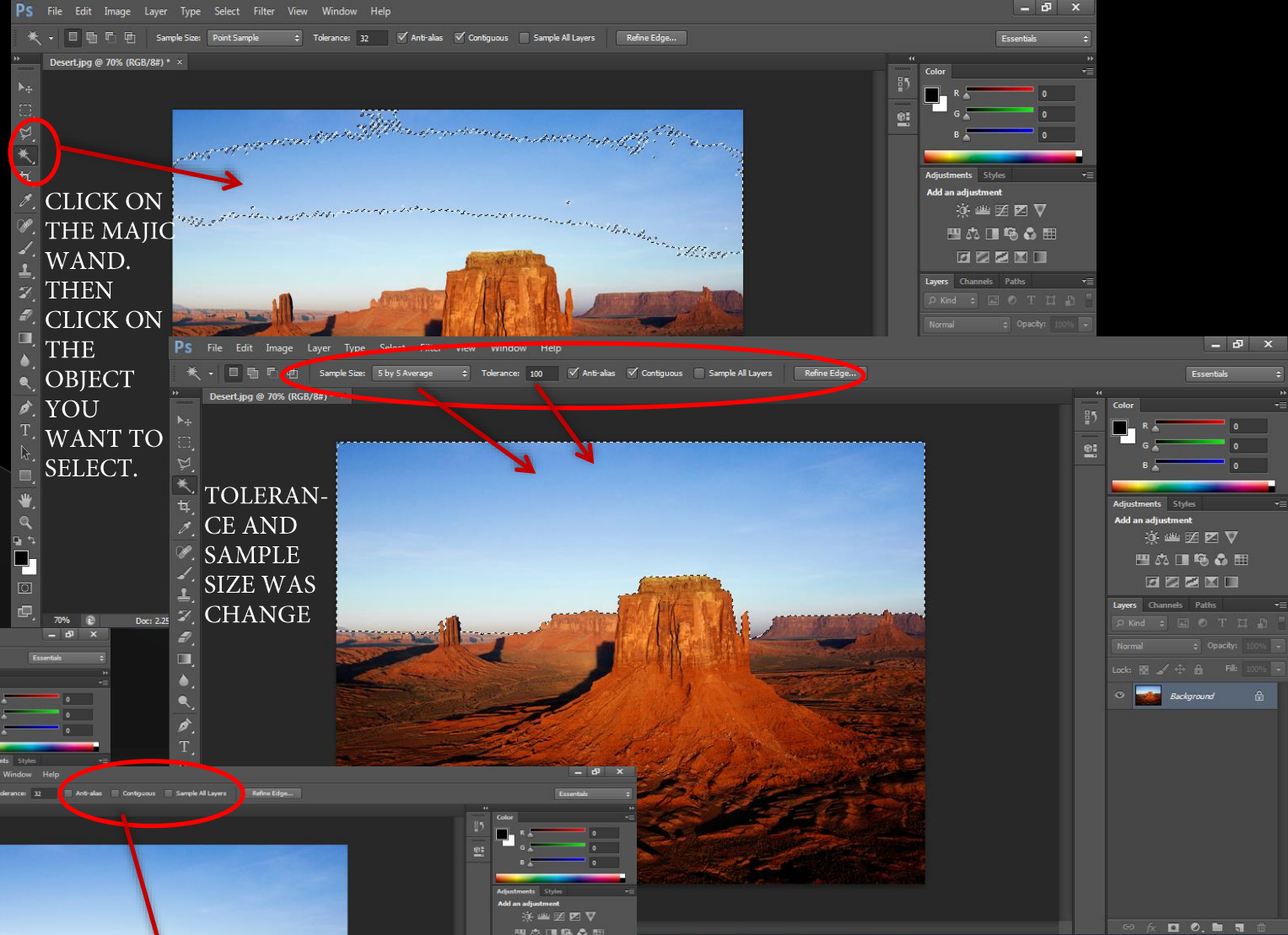
DESCRIPTION

MAGIC WAND

- The Magic Wand allows you to select sample points from a picture.
- You can change how much you want to select by changing the settings, located on the tool bar or simply by (shift-click)



CLICK ON THE MAGIC WAND. THEN CLICK ON THE OBJECT YOU WANT TO SELECT.

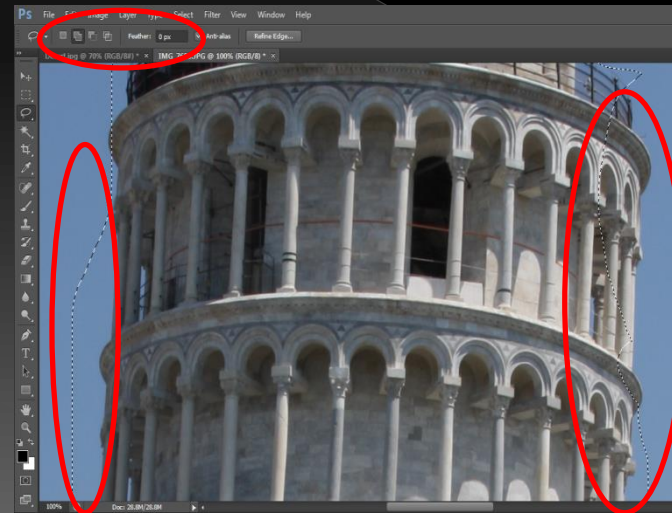
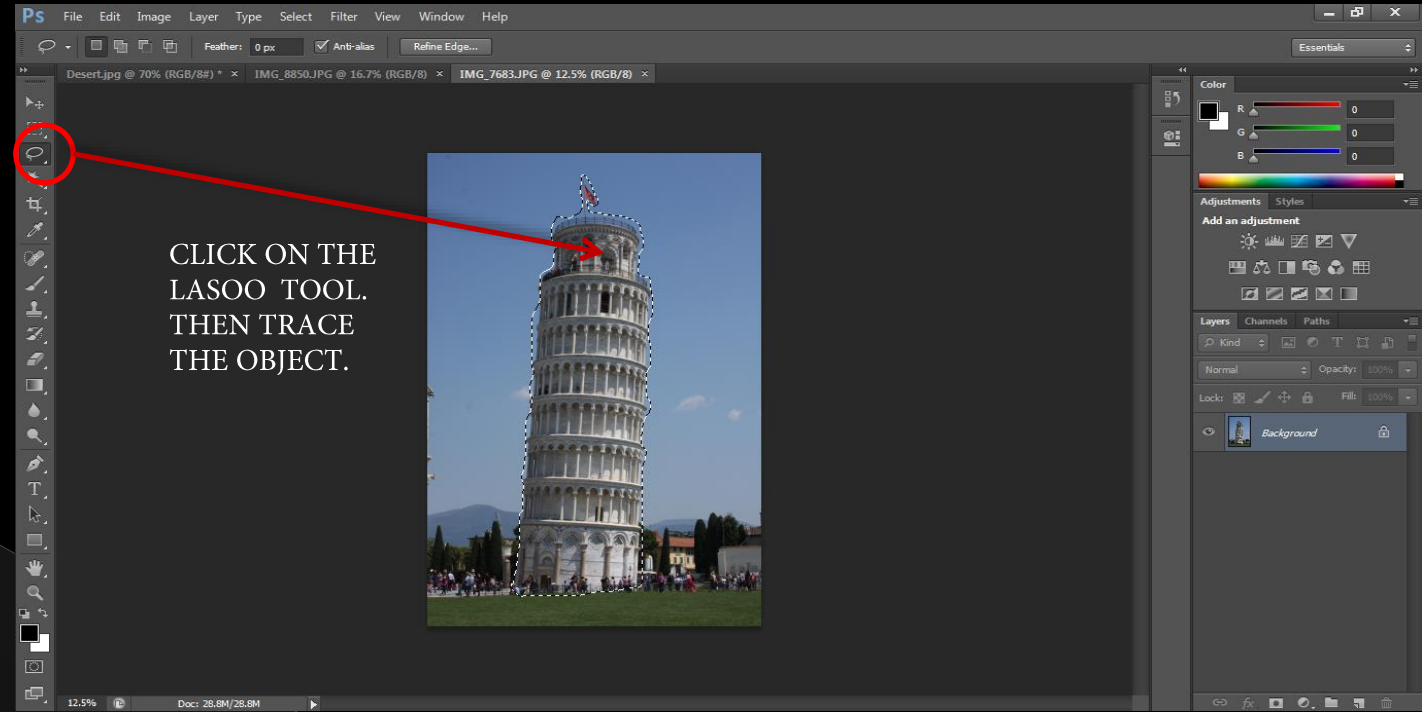

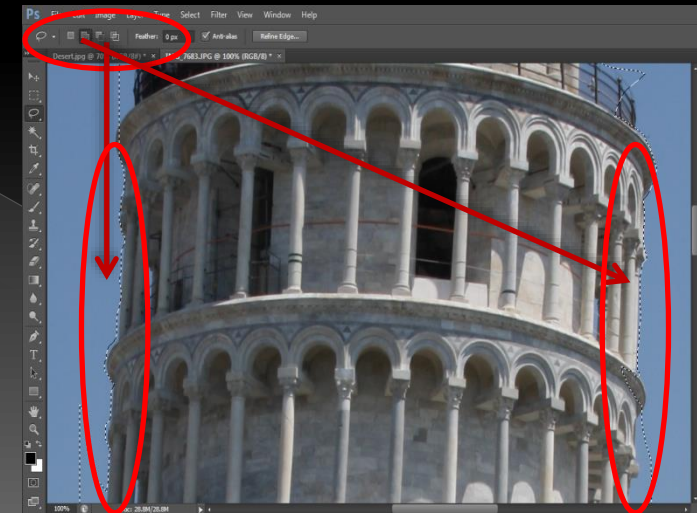
ANTI-ALIAS & CONTIGUOUS (OFF)

LASSO TOOL

- The Lasso Tool is used to select parts of an image in a free style manner. In other words, you draw what you want to select.
- You can add, subtract and soften the edges of the selection by changing the setting on the tool bar.



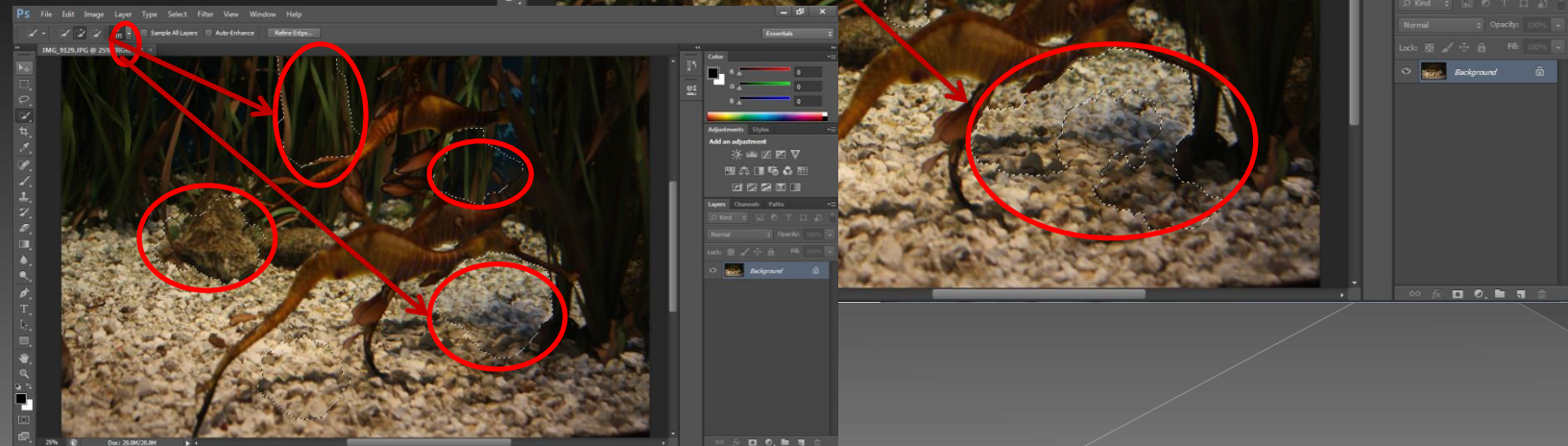
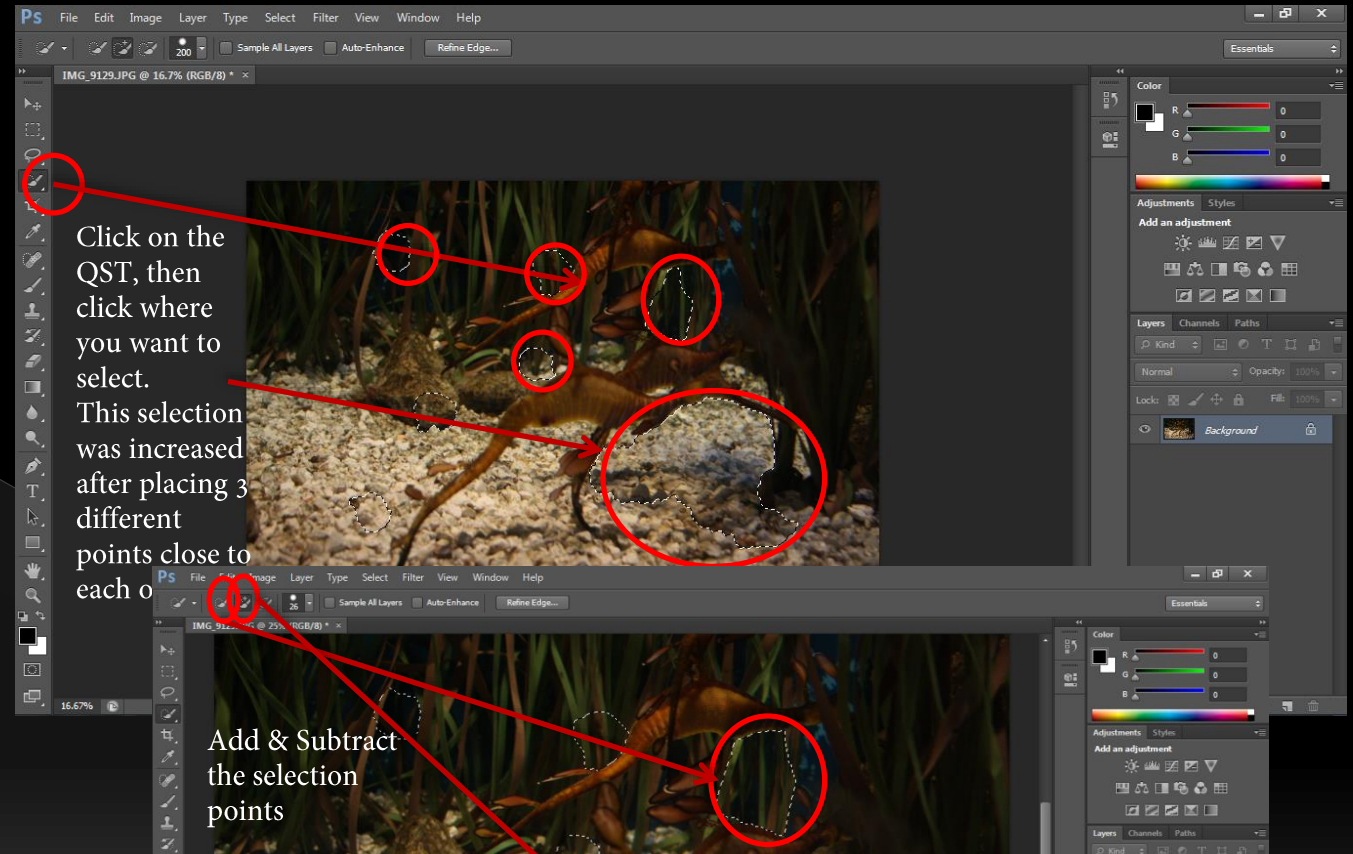

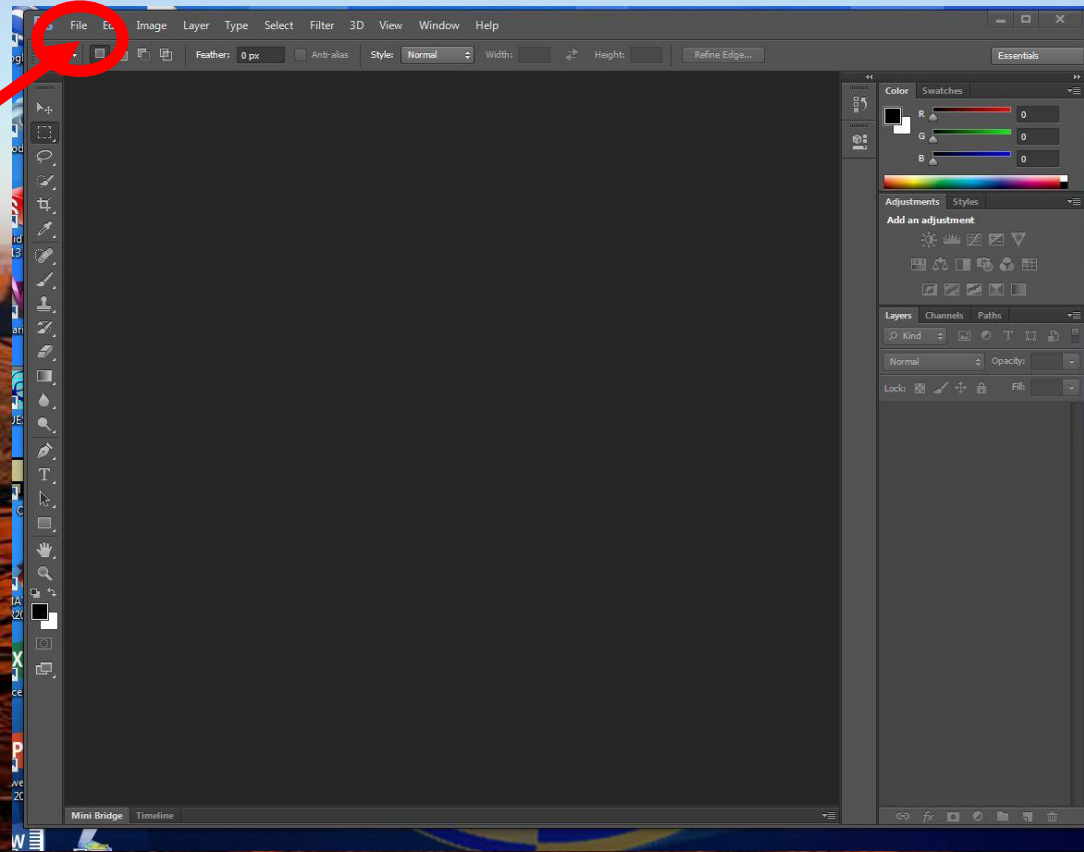

QUICK SELECTION TOOL

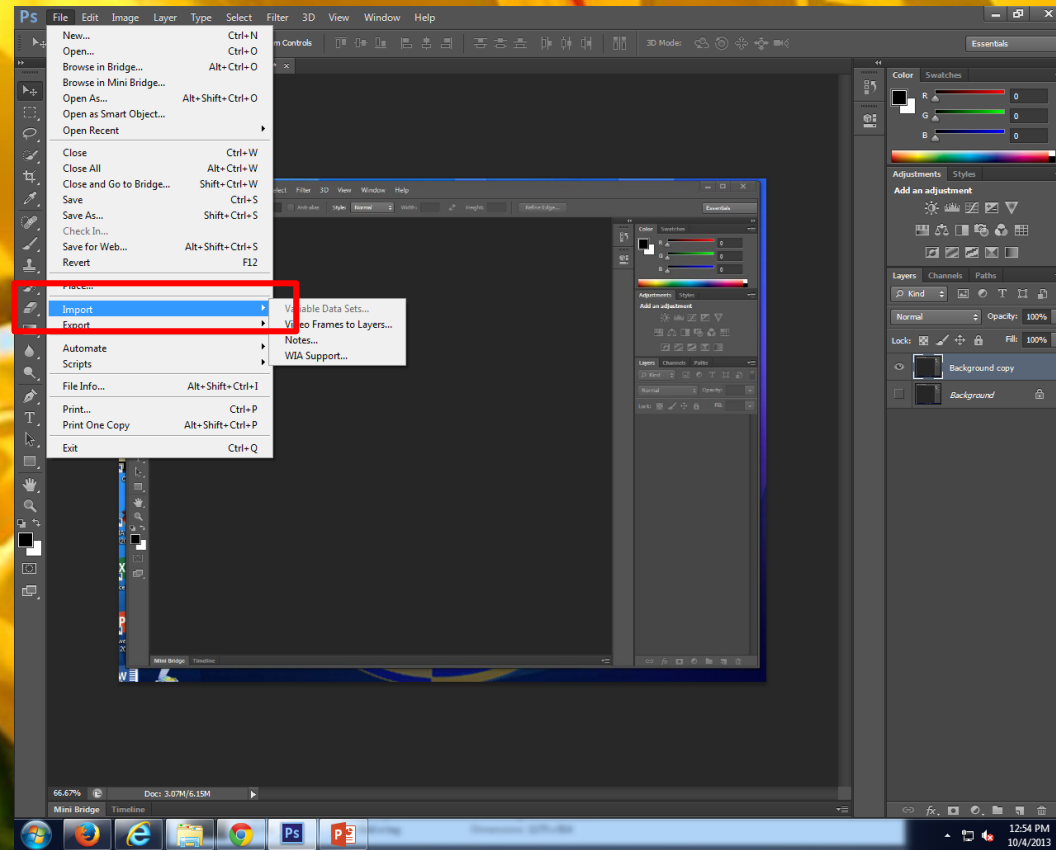
- The Quick Selection Tool is used to select points in a picture. However, if you place points close enough, it automatically selects a greater area.
- You can change the size, hardness, spacing, angle, and roundness of the brush kind of selection by changing the settings on the tool bar. You can also add or subtract from the selection.



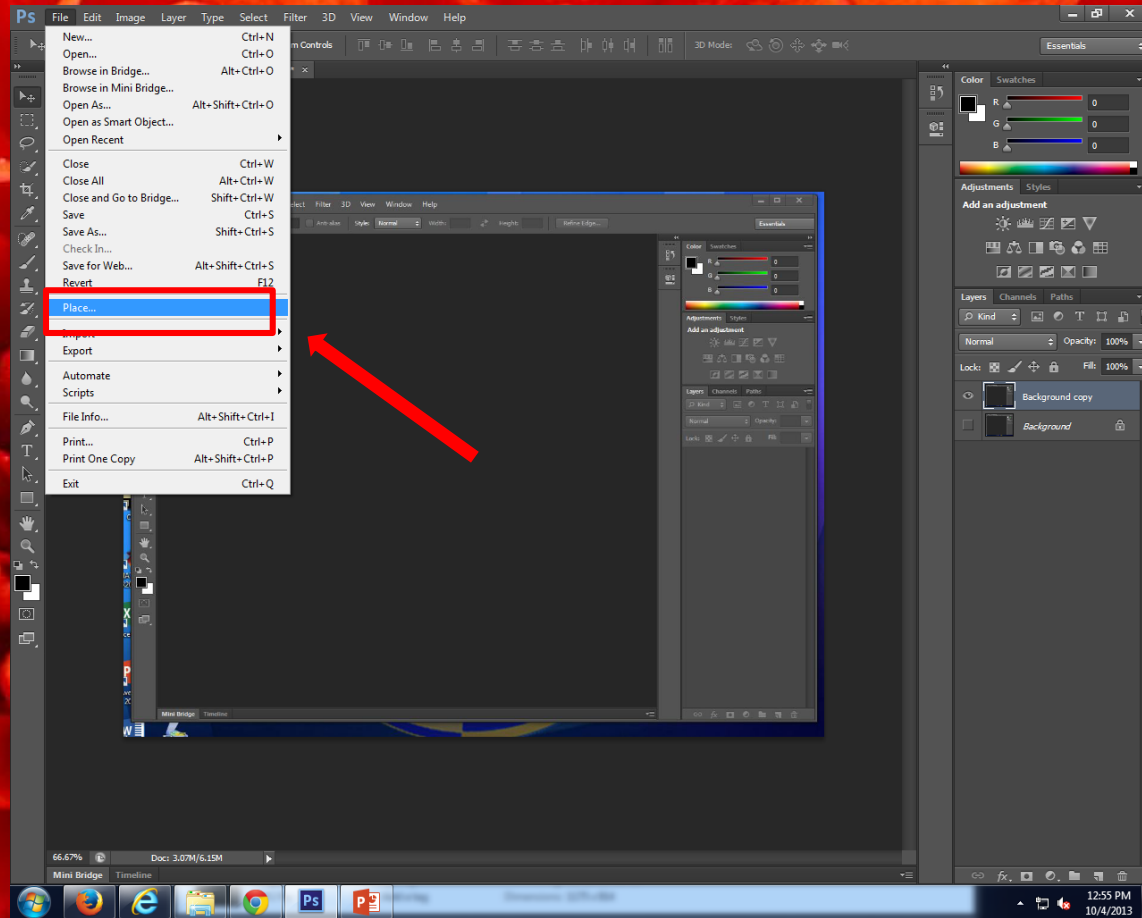

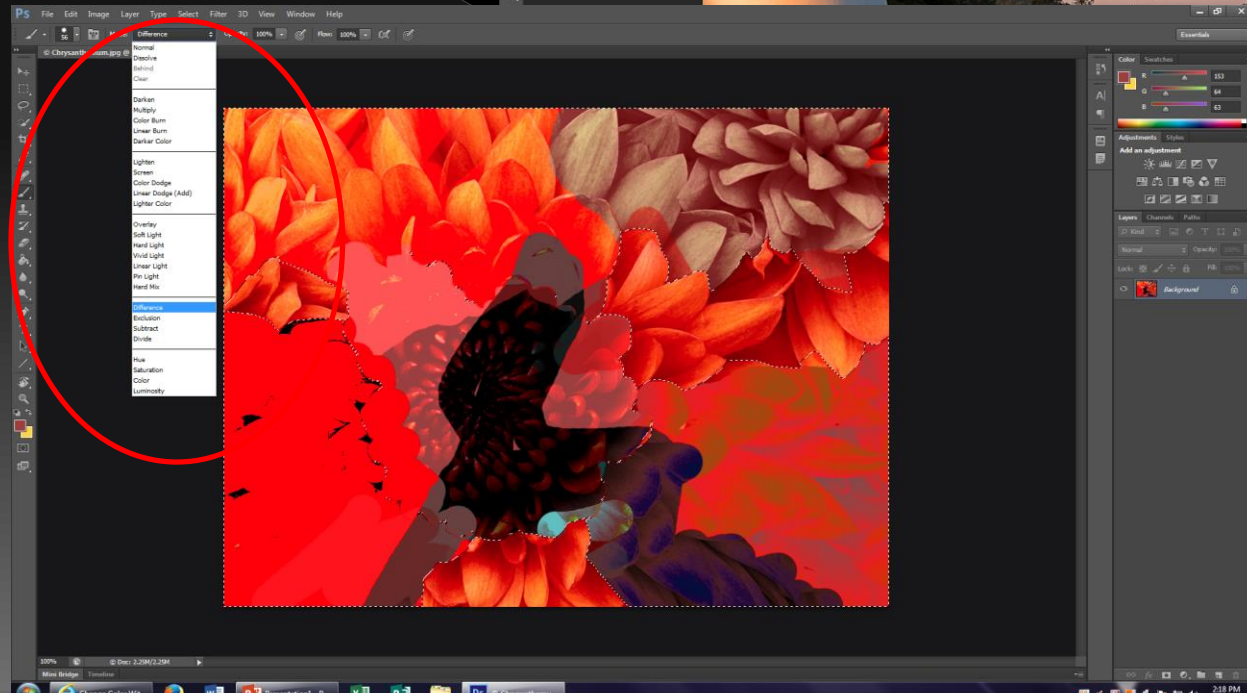
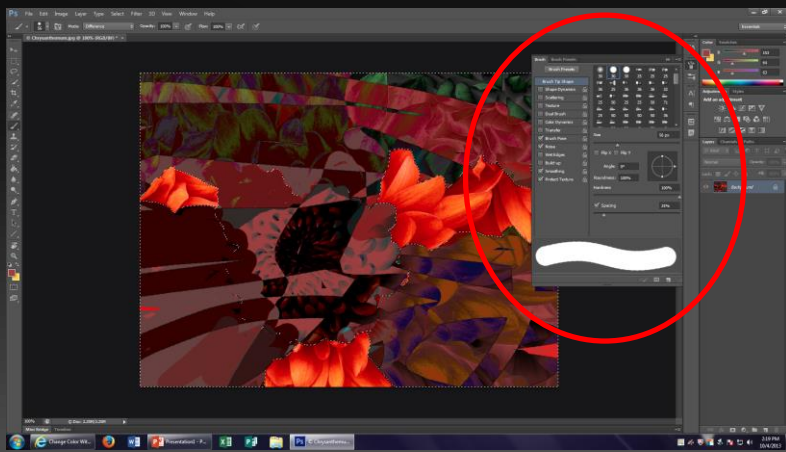
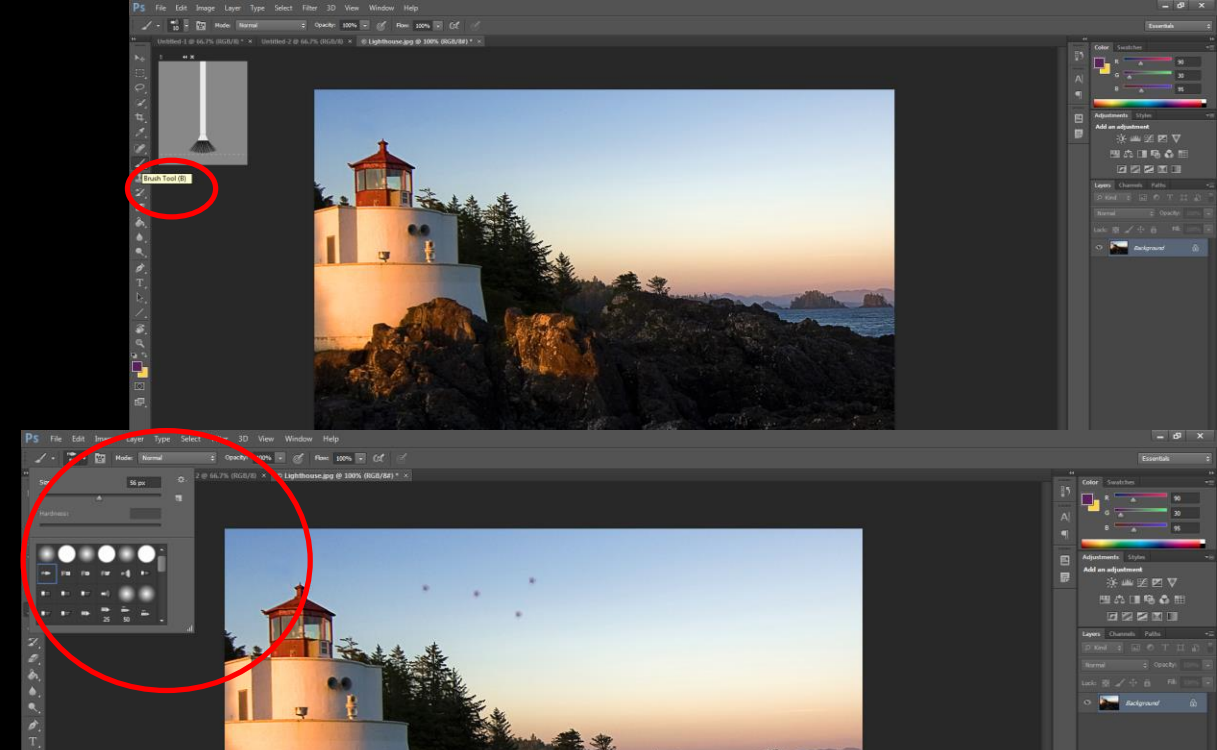
EYE DROPPER

- The eye dropper allows you to pick colors within your image as a foreground or background in your Color tool box.
- This tool also works very well with other tools. It allows you to copy the exact color from your picture.



BRUSH

- The brush allows you to paint and enhance different types or texture within your Photoshop document.
- **CLICK** your brush –Pick type suited for your pictures- Then begin to apply as Picasso would.
- There is way more to then applying paint to your photo when used with multiple tools you can create a different type of scenery.
