

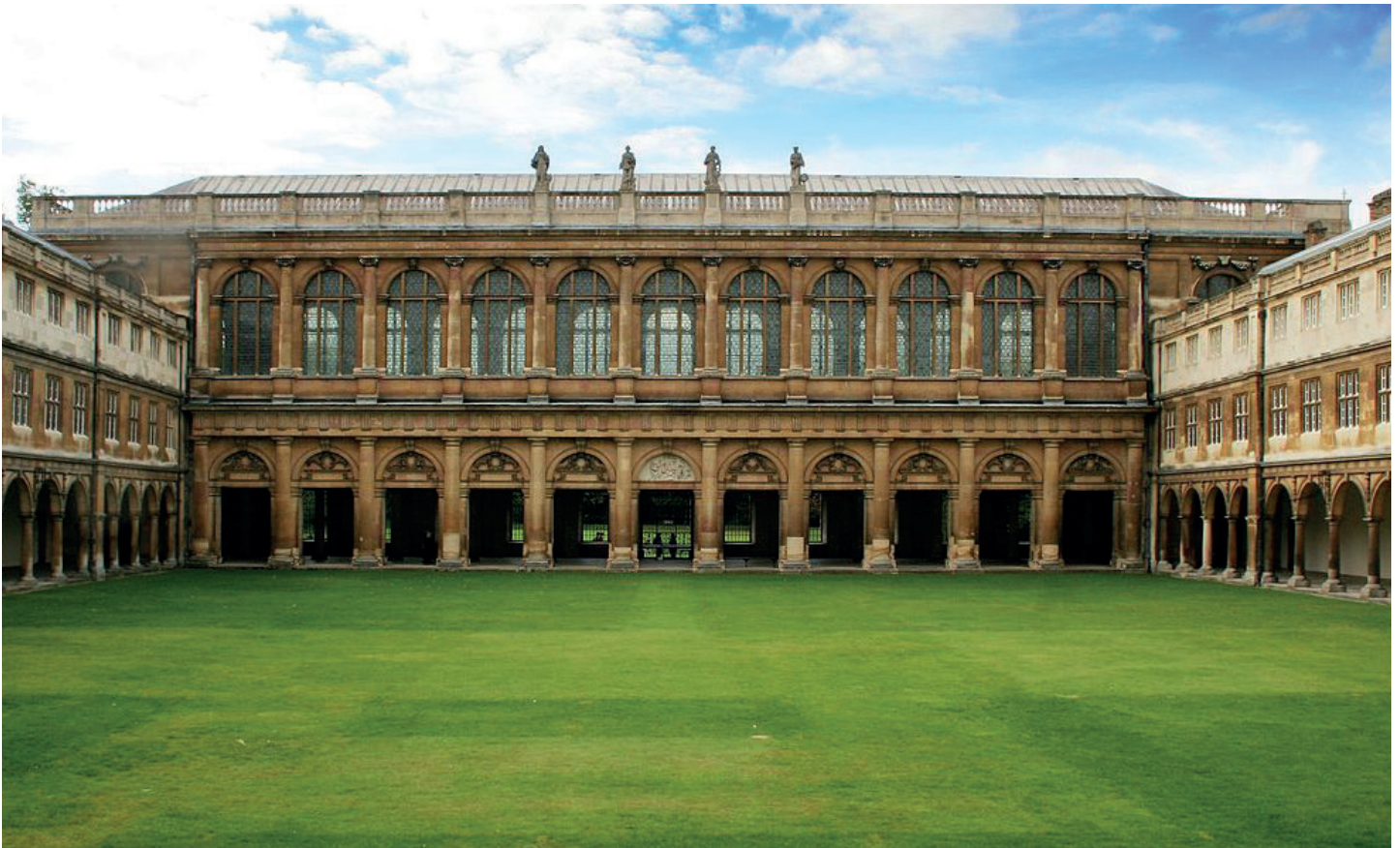

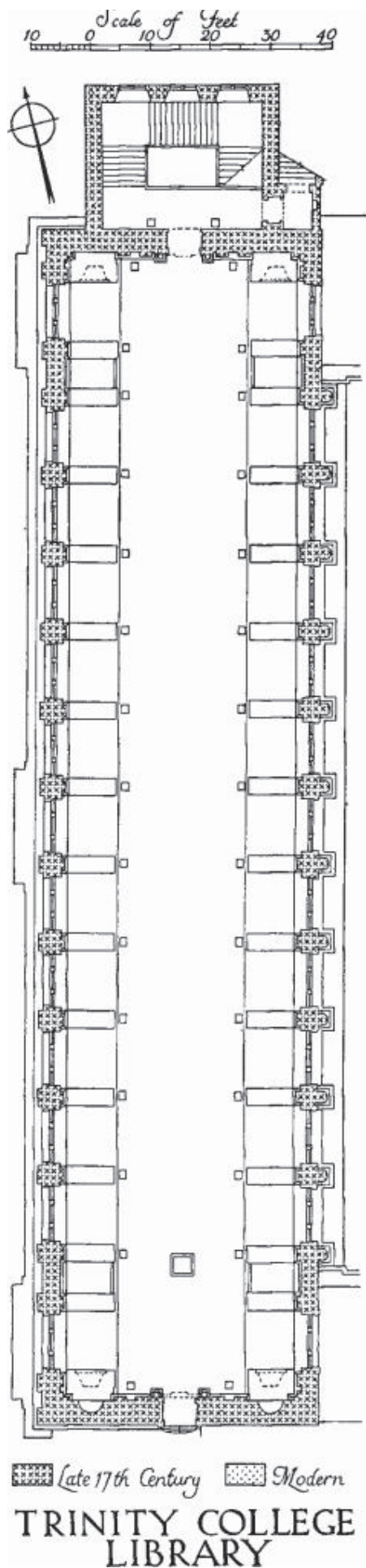


completed in 1695 this library design by Sir Christopher Wren, responsible for the design the construction of the building and also responsible of the furniture design.



He uses decorative wood-carving by Grinling Gibbons, the masonry of the library where carved by Roubiliac and Scheemakers, the statue of Lord Byron by Bertel Thorvaldsen, and the south facing painted glass window by Giovanni Battista Cipriani. 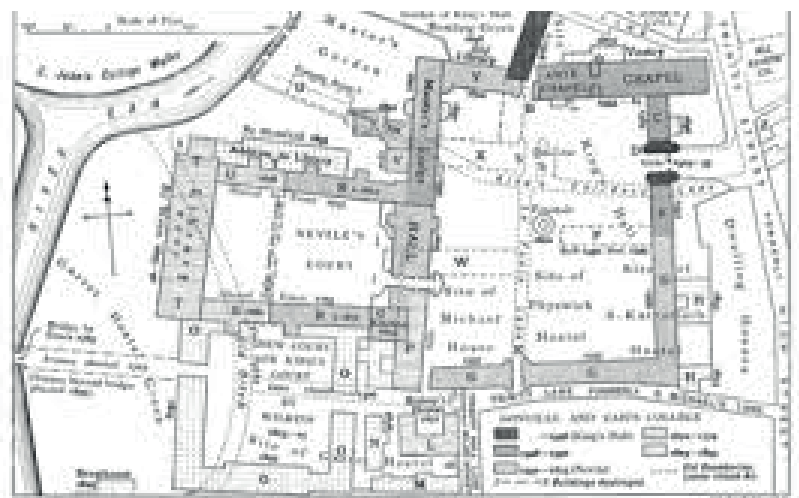
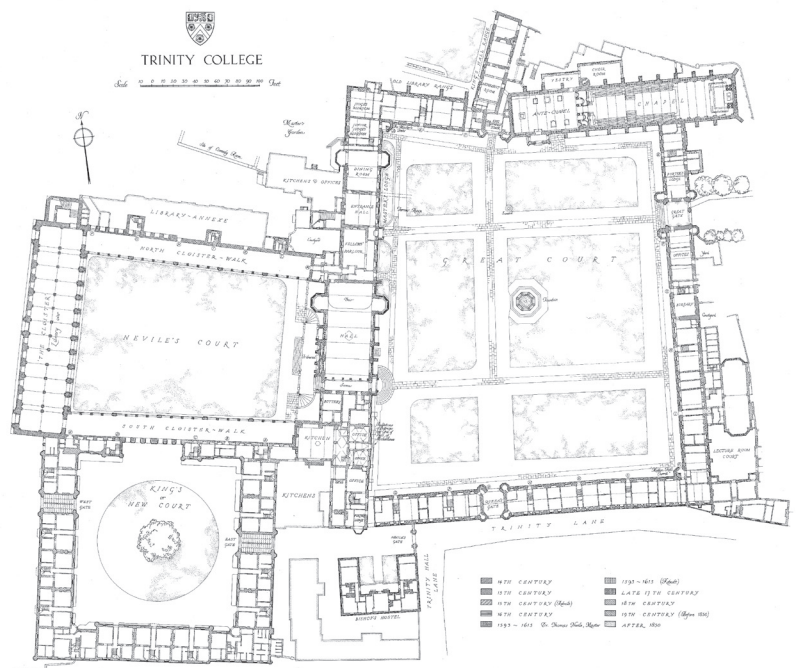
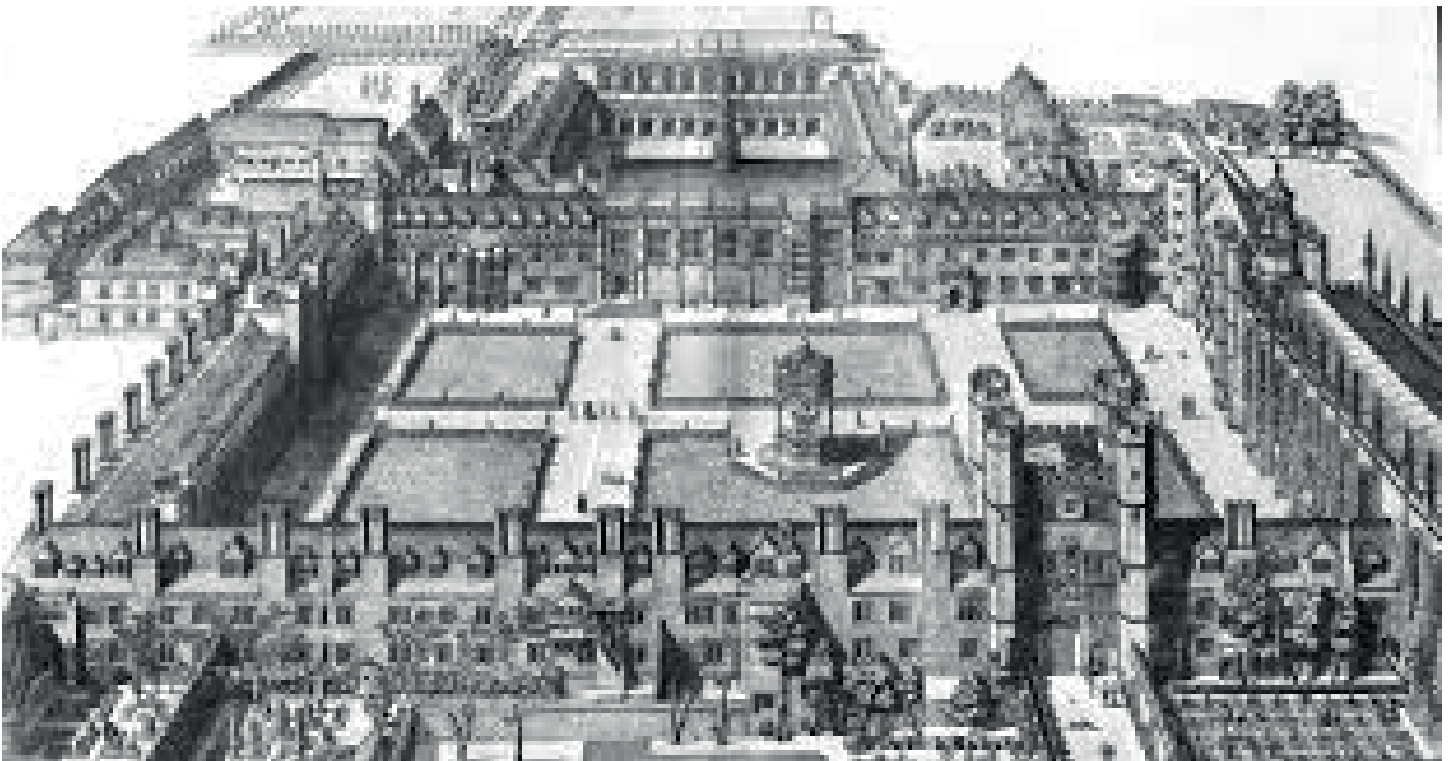
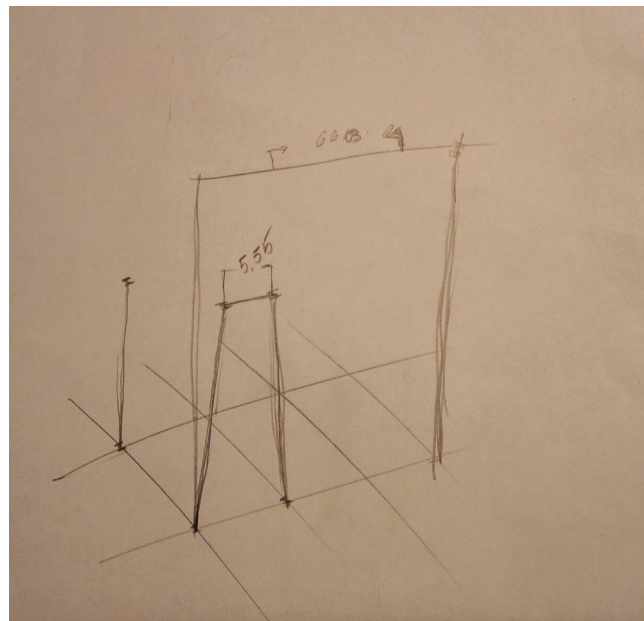
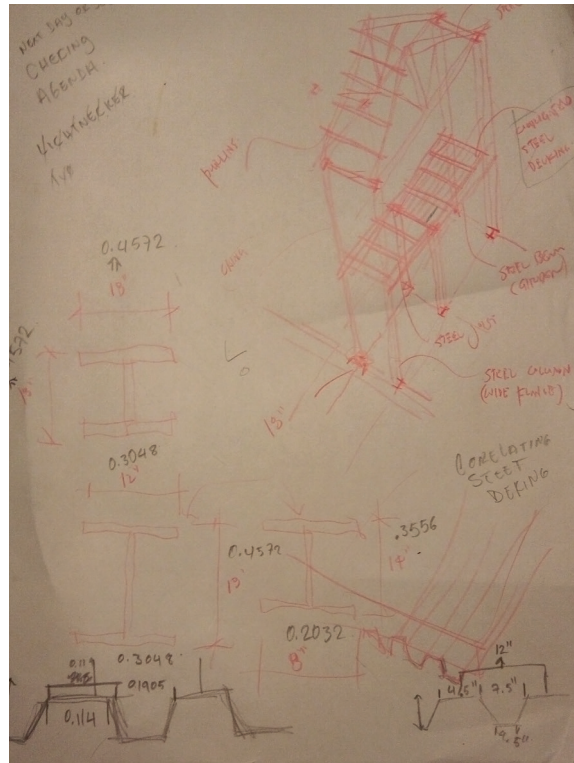


FIG. 25. Plan of Trinity College.
