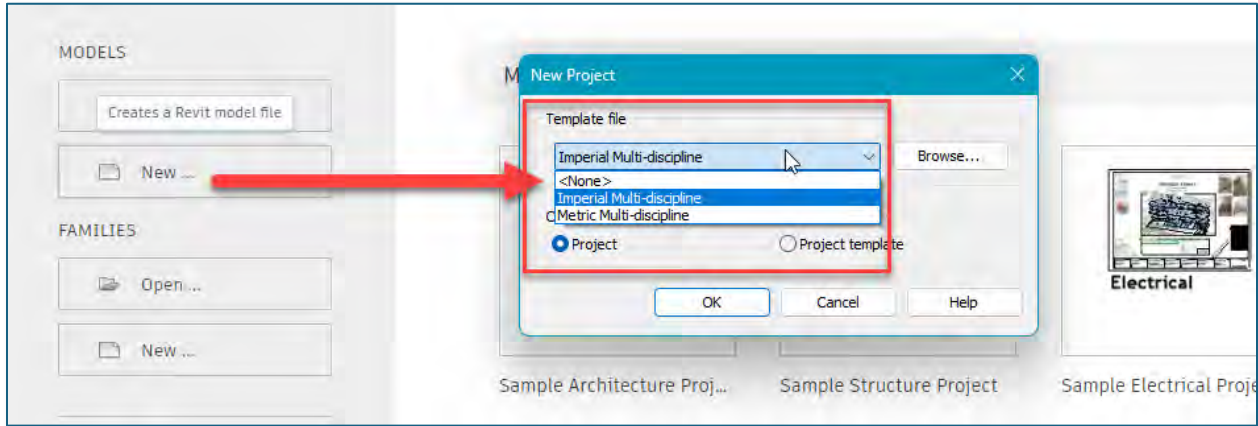


Adding Default Architecture Template to Revit 2024 by Prof. Paul King/Architecture

Check if template is missing. Run Revit and then select New > Project

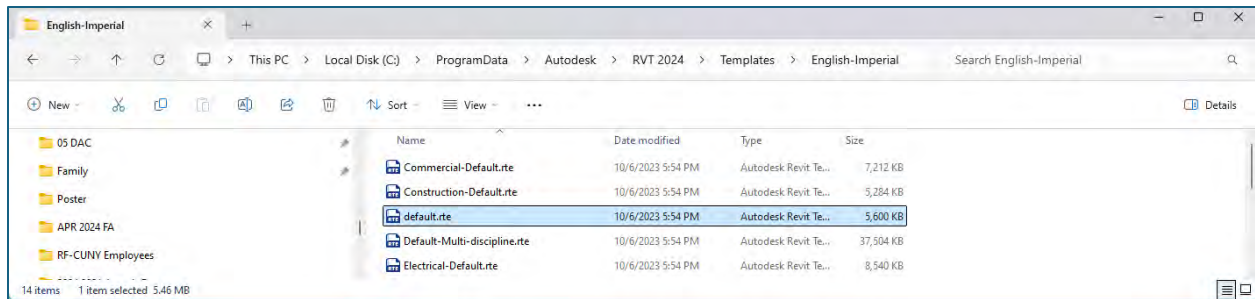
If only choices are Imperial and Metric Multi-discipline the template is not accessible



Be certain the template is installed on the PC. Navigate to the following path:

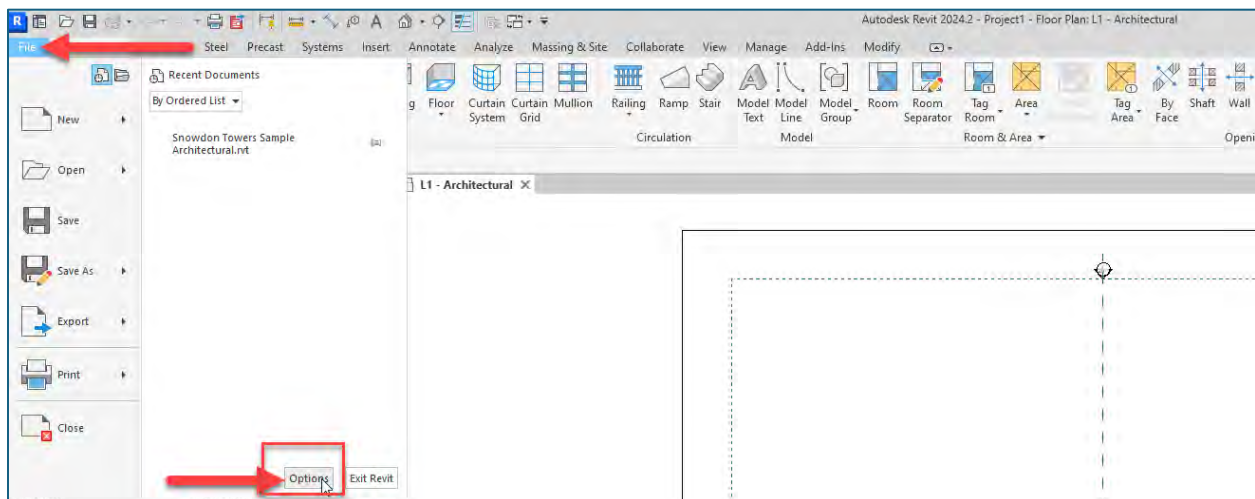
C:\ProgramData\Autodesk\RVT 2024\Templates\English-Imperial

This is a hidden directory - make sure it is visible before continuing

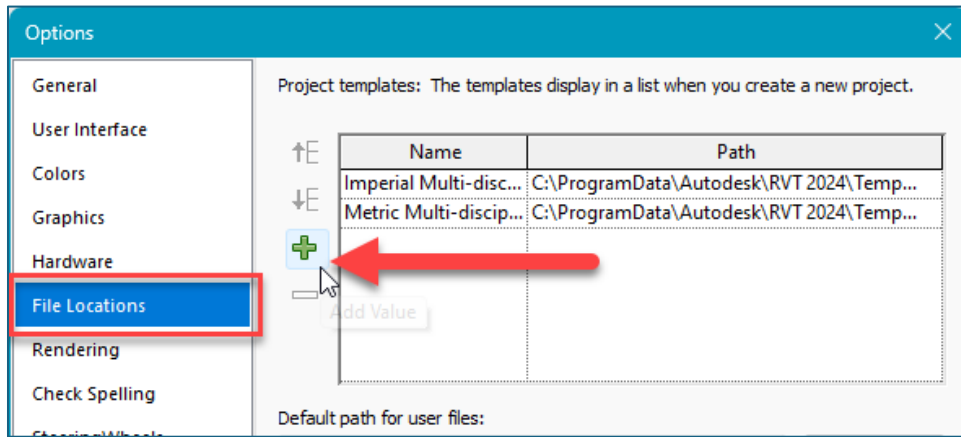


Back in Revit you must open any project file to access the “Options” command.

File Tab > Options

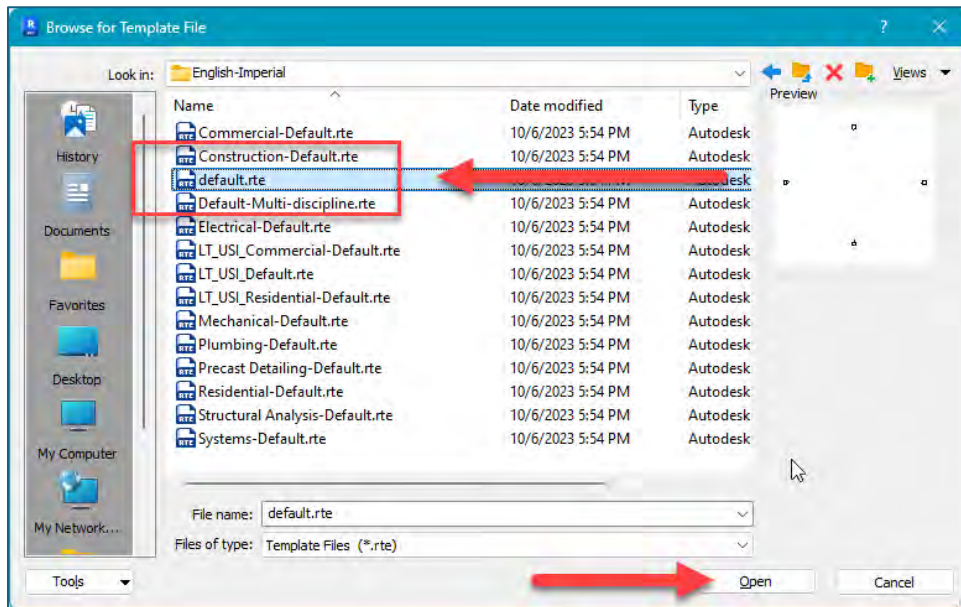


Select File Locations – then select the “+” sign to add a value

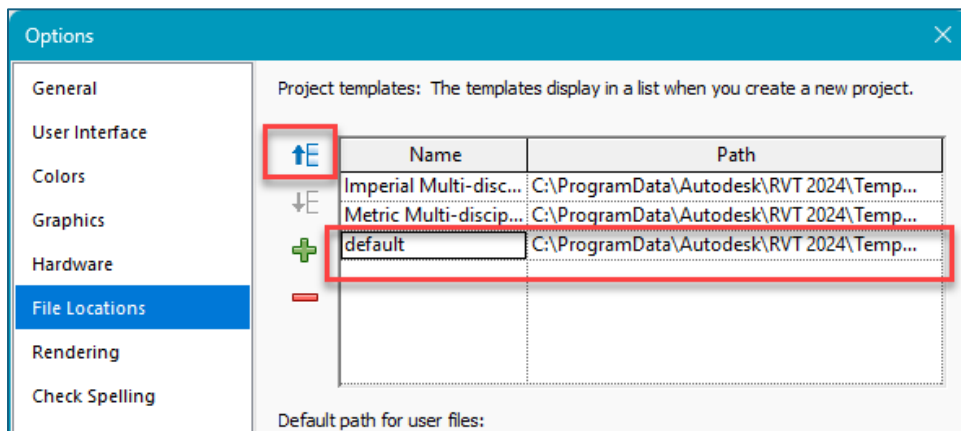


Navigate to the template directory and select “default.rte” then select open

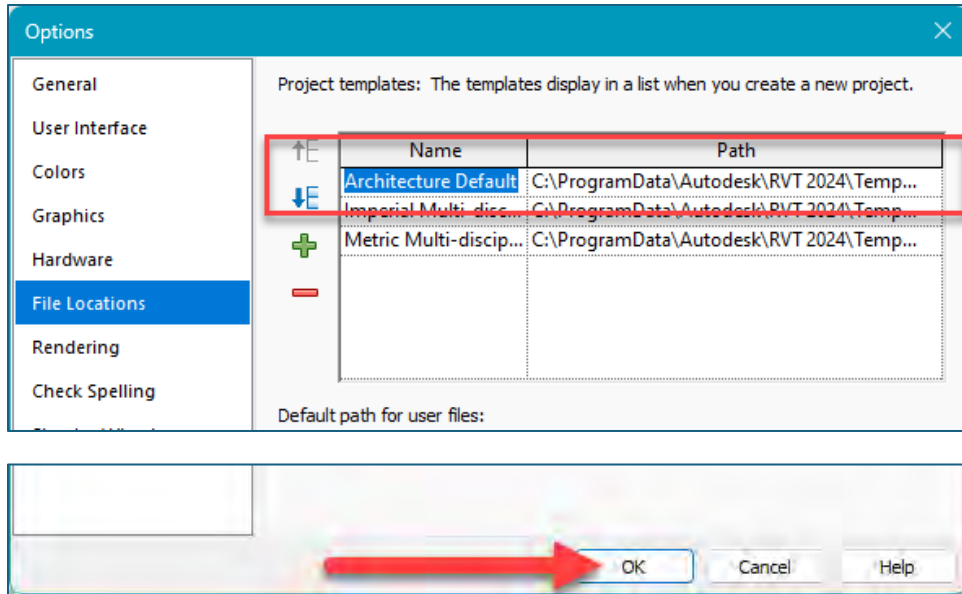
C:\ProgramData\Autodesk\RVT 2024\Templates\English-Imperial



Use the UP Arrow to move the “default” to the top of the list

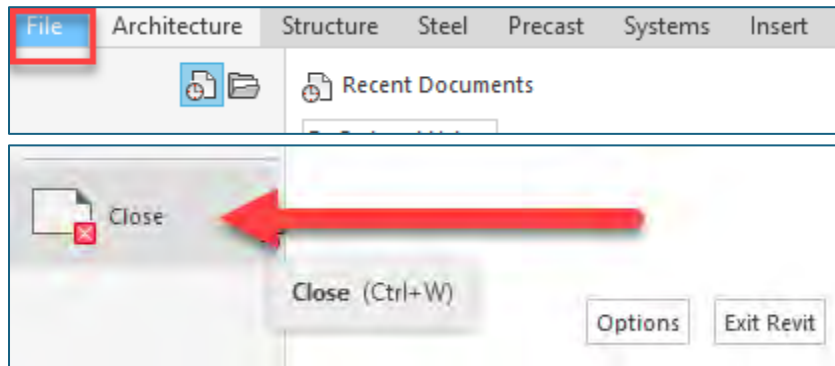


Rename “default” as “Architecture Default” then select OK



Confirm that template is setup correctly by starting a new project file.

First close any open Revit File



Next create a new project file New > Project

If setup correctly the new value is “Architecture Default” – close and exit Revit
