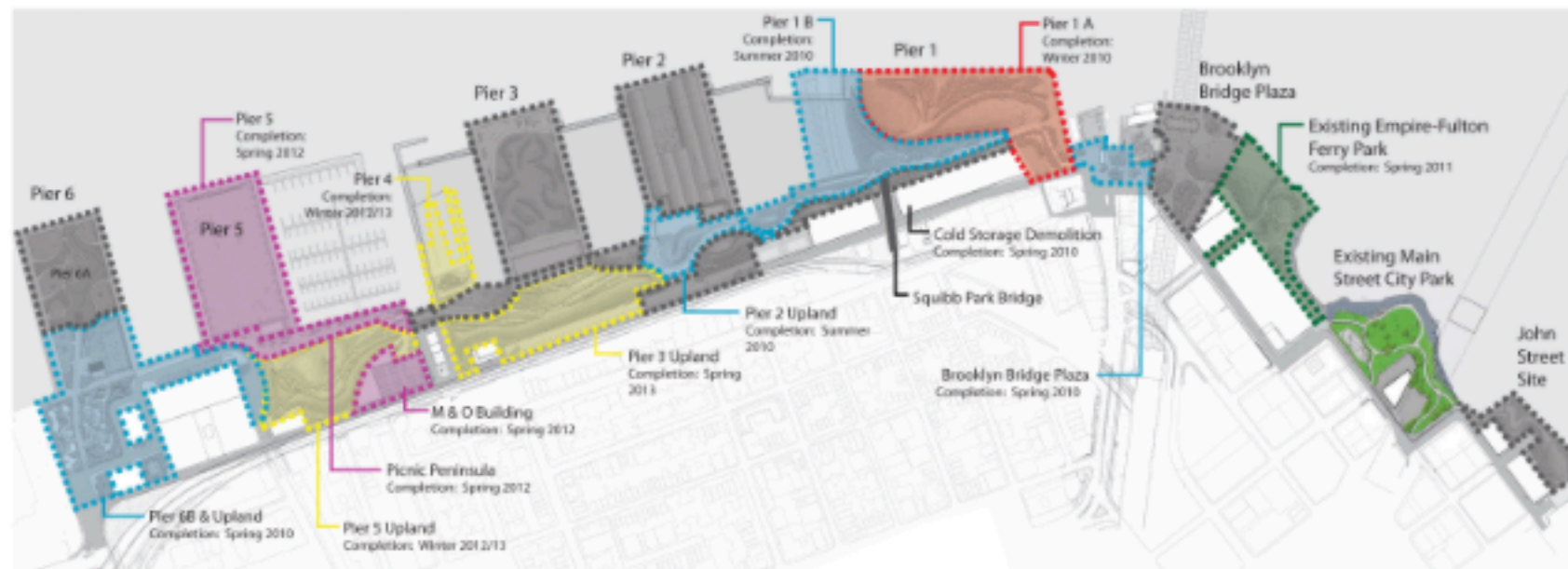

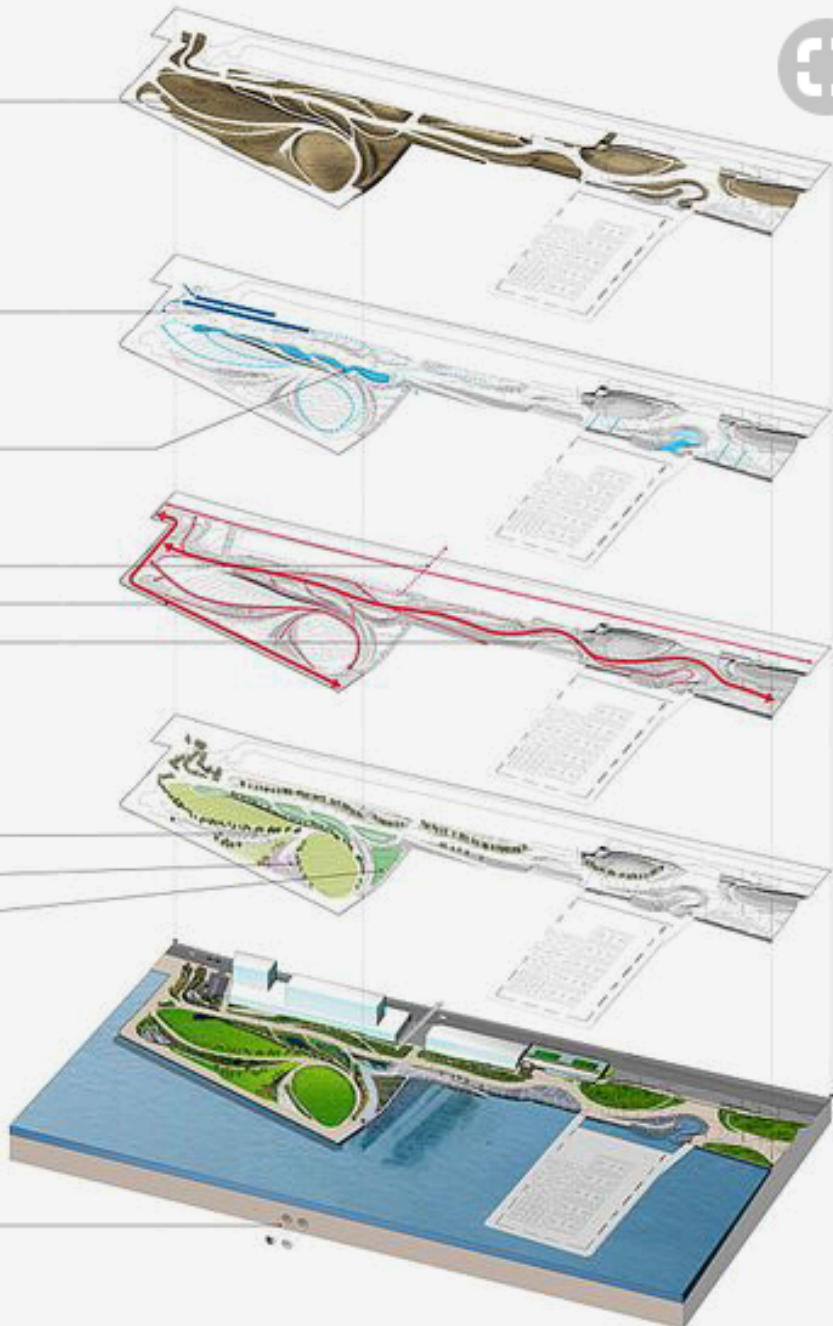

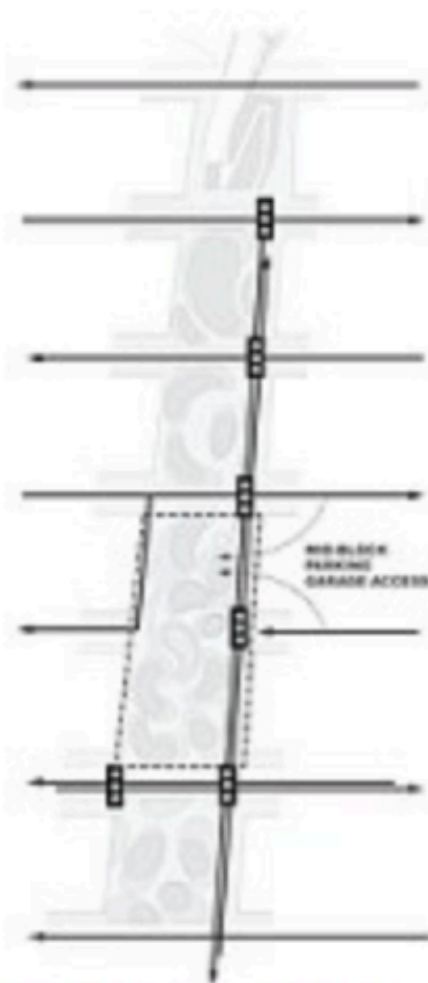

URBAN JUNCTIONS

After more than a century of the site supporting port related uses and being cut off from the city fabric, the idea of urban junctions was posed as a means to concentrate development at the park entries – connecting the city with the park.



Urban waterfronts accumulate complexity. The Brooklyn Bridge Park site has to accommodate both the program needs of the **PARK CONSTITUENCY** and maintain an extensive amount of **INFRASTRUCTURAL FUNCTIONS** for the city as a whole; while engaging in jurisdictions that extend well beyond the site boundaries.
