

## Seeking CTE Teachers in Electrical, Architecture, and Engineering

A candidate is generally eligible to teach a CTE subject if they any of the following:

- 4 years of industry experience **with** a high school diploma/equivalent **and** can pass the CQST exam, *OR*
- 2 years of industry experience **with** an Associates or higher, *OR*
- 2 years of postsecondary teaching, *OR*
- 1 year of industry experience **with** a Bachelor's or higher, *OR*
- A Bachelor's Degree **with** an Industry Related Credential

The degree and experience must be related to the CTE subject the candidate intends to teach. **If a candidate does *not* have their Transitional A certification yet, they can potentially be hired by a school as a substitute teacher and will be paid per diem @ \$199.27/day.** Only full-time teachers receive benefits thus it's important for the candidate to work on obtaining their Transitional A if they want to teach as a career.

Current openings include the following areas:

- Architecture (Manhattan, Queens)
- Electrical Installation (Staten Island)
- Engineering, which includes civil, electrical, mechanical, structural, or a related field (Manhattan, Queens)

Classes are in the daytime, Mon-Fri, roughly from 8AM-3PM. The current per diem pay rate is about \$199/day before taxes.
