



AIA STATEN ISLAND COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

The AIA SI College Scholarship Award recognizes outstanding students of the Staten Island community whose ambition and creative design thinking will positively influence the future of the architecture profession. The award is designed to promote the study and practice of architecture, engineering, or construction (AEC). This award aims to encourage academic pursuits within these fields and helps to defray costs associated with higher education.

- **Award**

One scholarship of **\$1,500** will be awarded. Entrants can re-apply throughout the duration of the applicant's **undergraduate and graduate pursuits**. Annual award at the discretion of the Chapter.

- **Qualifications**

Applicants **meeting a minimum of two** of the following criteria are encouraged to apply.

- Be enrolled or intending to enroll in a Vocational or College Program focusing on architecture, engineering, construction, or related field. Although not mandatory, preference is given to enrollment in a National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB) program.
- Maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- Upon graduation, recipients will receive a one-year complimentary associate membership to the AIA SI Chapter. Recipients are expected to participate in Chapter events as well as the Emerging Professionals committee. Participation may be in person and/or virtual.

- **Submission Materials***

Submissions must include and be in accordance with the all the guidelines below.

- Letter of nomination by the candidate stating the career interests and contributions to the Staten Island community. Subjects of nomination letter may include any or all of the following: record of providing meritorious service; demonstration of marked leadership; description of interest and skills in the AEC fields; scholastic achievements; Chapter participation capacity.
- Two examples of illustrative creative work. ie drawings.
- Up to 2 recommendation letters: 1 academic reference letter and 1 personal reference letter (should speak to extracurricular activities, community contributions, character, etc)
- School transcript
- Photo. Preferably a head shot.

** All submission materials may be used by the Chapter and related entities.*

Applications for the 2023-2024 AIA Staten Island College Scholarship will open **Fall 2024**.
