Head of Akkadian ruler, from Nineveh, Iraq (modern Kuyunjik), c.2250-2200 BC

Victory stele of Naram-Sin, from Susa, Iran, c.2254-2218 BC

Babylonian

Stele with law Code of Hammurabi (Hammurabi and Shamash). c.1780 BC

Statue of Menkaure and Queen Khamerernebtj, Giza, 2490-2472 BC

New Kingdom (c.1550-1070 BC)

Mortuary Temple of Hatshepsut, Deir el-Bahri, c.1473-1458 BC

Innermost coffin of Tutankhamen, c. 1323 BC, from the Valley of the Kings, Thebes

Death mask of Tutankhamen, c. 1323 BC, from the Valley of the Kings, Thebes

Amarna Period (Amenhotep IV/Akhenaton) (c.1353-1335 BC)

Statue of Akhenaten (Amenhotep IV) from Karnak, c.1353-1350 BC
