To complete the **2025-2026 FAFSA** (For Summer 2025, Fall 2025 & Spring 2026) go to https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa

You will need the following documents/information with you to complete your application:

- Your 2023 W2/ 1099 form /1040 federal tax returns form (If you worked and/or filed taxes in 2023) **
- Your Parent (s) 2023 W2/ 1099 form / 1040 federal tax returns form, if you are dependent.**
- Your FSA ID and Password.
- All contributors will need an FSA ID and Password as well. (Contributors are Spouse, Parent, Step Parent). Each Contributor will need to login and complete their section.

After you've submitted your FAFSA, you <u>must</u> also complete your <u>2025-2026 TAP Application</u>. Do not log out of the FAFSA. Click on the "Start your state application" link on the online FAFSA confirmation page to complete your TAP application after submitting the FAFSA.
