

E-portfolio - what needs to be on it for 25% of your grade?

1. Your personal customized logo/banner with a written paragraph and explanation of why it represents you.
2. Your Bio of yourself, 2 or 3 paragraphs telling us about yourself, complete with hyperlinks to City Tech page and other sites you mention that gives the reader a strong sense of you as a developing artist and student.
3. Your Logo/Research project and the Designers Research Paper in Digital Media Foundations and the Academic Samples for COMD 1112.
4. The Visually Enhanced Quotes explaining (3) different versions of the same quote. It needs to have an explanation of each quote telling us how you made it and why. Also, what fonts were used in the quote? Whatever information you can give. It should be uploaded on your e-portfolio under Digital Media Foundations and the Academic Samples, COMD 1112. The presentation of the quote project on your Open Lab site is also factored into your overall Open Lab site grade, which is 15% of your final grade, so make sure you have all elements of the project on the site.
5. Your personal poster which portrays Gordon Parks the photographer.
6. The Life in a Day video. It could be a fun activity of a day over the weekend, again with your explanation of how you came up with the ideas to film. (It will end up being a 1-2 minute video. We will edit the film in a film editing program.)
7. Field trip report with 3 prints from the virtual field trip

This makes up your e-portfolio.
