ENG 1101-D381 Project 5: Revision and Reflection Fall 2013

After you finish writing your research essay on your chosen location and planning and delivering your speech on the location you have chosen to study, we will have one more round of assignments related to this topic.

Project #5 will have three parts:

1-To accompany your embedded video in our Being in Brooklyn Google Map, write a 35-word summary of your research essay. Make it exactly 35 words.

2-Write a summary of your research essay, Project #4, in 200 words. Aim for no more than 5% variation in length either way, so no shorter than 190 words, no longer than 210 words. Use the techniques we've discussed for writing a summary. Rules about omitting opinion from summary still apply. Your summary should still include in-text citations and a Works Cited page as appropriate.

3-In an additional 300-400 words, write a letter of advice to next year's student sitting in your seat, taking the same classes, as he or she embarks on this location-focused endeavor.

To complete this assignment, use what you have already written plus the comments you have gotten on your speech and essay to be able to submit your best possible work. Post your summary on our course site as a blog post, include a title for your entry in the subject line, and select the category Project 5. Use the tag Brooklyn Tour and two other tags to integrate your work into the course site. Post your letter as a post with the category Project 5 and the tag Advice, plus at least one other tag. Include a subject line that reflects the advice you're including in your letter.
