<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>What is the first image?</li> </ul>	The first image shows a person gossiping
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Main point of the intro.</li> </ul>	Four Foundation to stand on it we want our speech to be powerful and to make change in the world
<b>BODY:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>What image starts this section? Is it tied to another quote or description or question?</li> </ul>	The image that starts this section was the word HAIL which simply means to greet enthusiastically. H-Honesty A-Authenticity I-Integrity L-Love
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Point 1 (personal experience, observation, example)</li> </ul>	Register knowing that you can change your voice
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Point 2 (personal experience, observation, example)</li> </ul>	Timbre knowing you need to know your posture
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Point 3 (personal experience, observation, example)</li> </ul>	Prosody means being monotonous and changing the way you speak
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Other points (personal experience, observation, example)</li> </ul>	Pace and pitch means to vary your speech with speed and depth
<b>CONCLUSION:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Image to lead into or start conclusion.</li> </ul>	Image showing the consciousness of speaking
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>How does the image relate to the topic?</li> </ul>	The image concludes his point by showing how knowing your sound consciously will help make speaking and listening easier.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Final element: suggestion or advice about how to take what you've said and use it to their advantage, question for them to think about, quote &amp; who said it, analogy.</li> </ul>	He goes on to talk about HAIL and I enjoyed it because it's true that people who do those things rarely find people to talk to in the world
