BODY:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• What image could start this section?	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Point 1 (personal experience, observation, example)	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Point 2 (personal experience, observation, example)	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Point 3 (personal experience, observation, example)	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Other points (personal experience, observation, example)	
CONCLUSION:	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Image to lead into or start conclusion.	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• How does the image relate to the topic?	
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Final element: suggestion or advice about how to take what you've said and use it to their advantage, question for them to think about, quote & who said it, analogy.
