## WHO CAN APPLY?

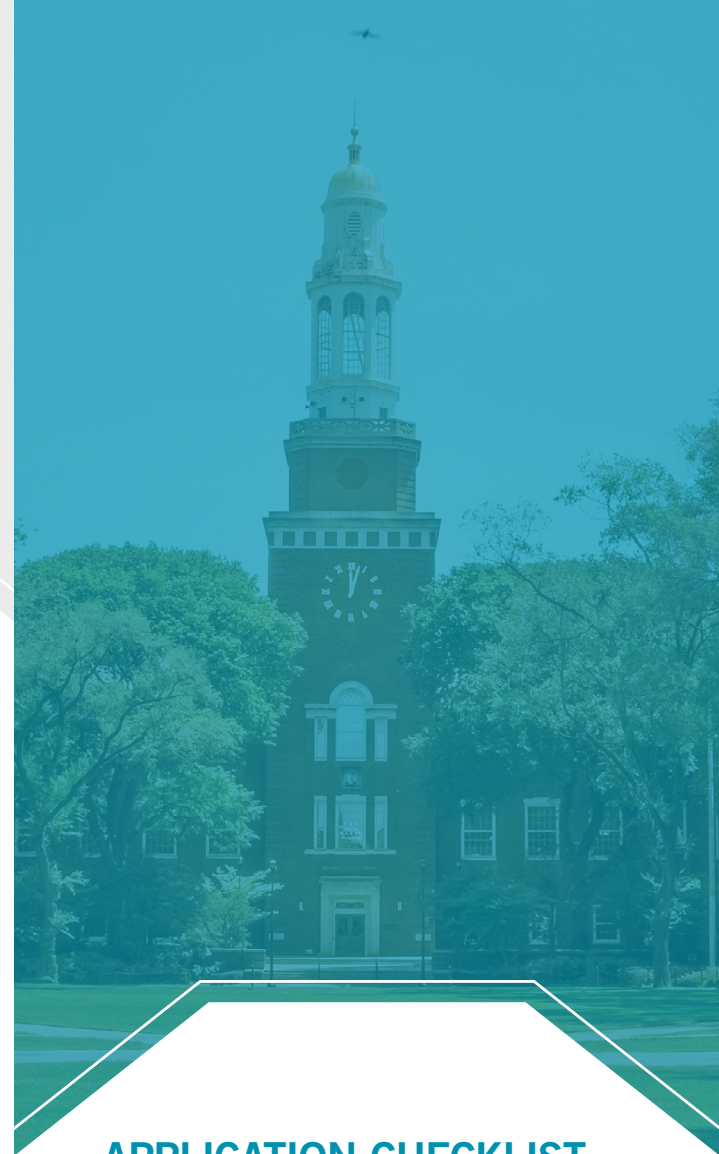
- First year undergraduate students in the associate degree programs in LAS, LAA (psychology) Chemical Technology, Unclassified (UC) or Unclassified Health (UCH)
- Students who have a strong interest in a career in biomedical or behavioral sciences
- Students who started their undergraduate careers at City Tech
- 12-36 credits completed at the time of acceptance into the program
- GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Full-time student
- U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Member of under-represented group (Blacks or African Americans, Hispanics or Latinos, American Indians or Alaskan Natives, and native Hawaiians or other Pacific Islanders)

## WHY I SHOULD JOIN?

- Customized Academic Success Plan
- Peer Mentor Initiative in Mathematics and Chemistry
- Paid Authentic Research Experiences
- **\$700** Research Skills Academy: Three week training program that includes seminars, workshops and field trips
- **\$1,200/semester** Second Year Experience: 10 weeks/semester of Faculty mentored research
- **\$3,400** Summer Bridge Research: 8 weeks of immersive mentor research at Brooklyn College
- Opportunity to present at local & national scientific meetings
- Continued support at Brooklyn College

## REQUIREMENTS TO STAY IN THE PROGRAM

- Maintain GPA of 2.8 or higher
- Full-time status
