Tasks

This week's tasks are a little more difficult than the weeks before. I'm working on creating 85-90 test suites, which include well written instructions on how the most important features that must be tested routinely in the app on difficult devices.

Challenges

Writing test suites this week has been a bit of a challenge because I'm unsure of who will be testing and if they have knowledge of every feature since, many QA people test different things they aren't always aware of other features. For example, I have to ensure that if I'm writing a test suite for someone who will be looking at and testing chat features, I have to be sure to specify the exact chat features such as sending snaps or messages to a group of friends rather than one individual. This has also been a challenge because the amount of test suites we need to rewrite are much more than expected and if they are not written correctly then I can be held liable for a feature that may be passed untested or not tested to the best ability.

Outcomes and Growth

Whole this week has been difficult and a bit of a learning curve for me in terms of writing such a large amount of instructions. I was happy to realize my major courses really helped prepare me for such intense and tedious work. I've learned that I have become much better at writing

detailed, short, and simple instructions and based on the feedback I received the end user is satisfied with the outcome and simplicity of the instructions.
