- Candidates start an NCARB Council Record, (even if they have no work experience)
- City Tech sends a transcript directly to NCARB indicating completion of at least the 3rd year of the B.Arch program or graduation from the BTech program.
- request to take the ARE as a NY candidate within their NCARB Record,
- submit a NYS Application (form 1) and fee of \$377. http://www.op.nysed.gov/prof/arch/archforms.htm
- If you started at City Tech before Fall 2018, include form 4 to verify applicable work experience
- The State Board will then review the application to determine if the candidate meets NY's ARE eligibility requirements.
