## Skill Drill: Inches to Picas

## l inch = 6 picas $=72$ points

- Points are the smallest unit of measurement. Type and leading are measured in points with 72 points to the inch.
- Use picas for measuring column width and depth, margins, and other larger distances.
- Picas and points have a direct relationship to each other. There are 12 points in a pica.
- If you're a metric maven you may have a bit more trouble with the conversion to picas, but for those of us raised on inches it's simpler. There are 6 picas to an inch. A standard US letter size page is 8.5 by 11 inches or 51 by 66 picas. ( 6 picas are The letter $p$ is used to designate picas as in $22 p$ or $6 p$.
- With 12 points to the pica, half a pica would be 6 points written as 0 p6. 17 points would be 1 p5 (1 pica = 12 pts, plus the leftover 5 pts).
