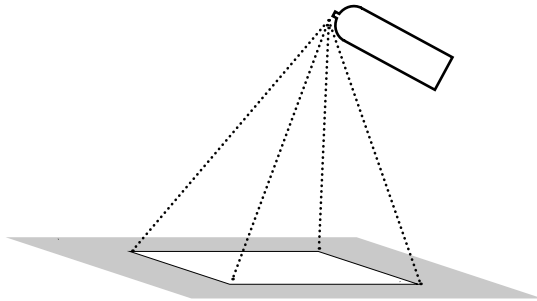


Mounting Your Artwork

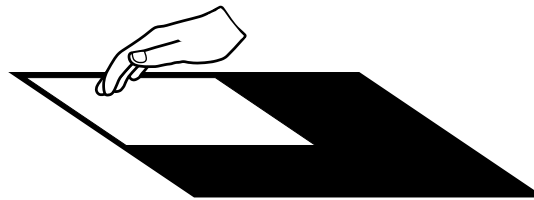
Supplies Needed

- 1 Sheet black foam core, 1/4 inch thick
- Spray mount
- X-acto knife with some fresh blades
- Metal ruler, cork-backed to keep from slipping
- A copy of your artwork
- Some newspaper



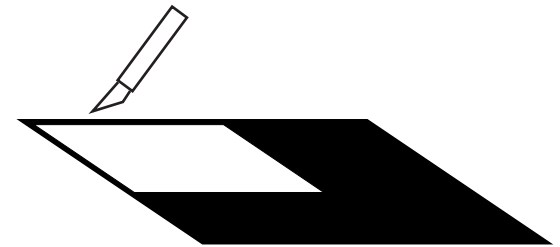
STEP ONE: Spray adhesive on artwork

1. Lay some newspaper down on the ground to protect your artwork
2. Lay your artwork on the newspaper face down
3. Hold the can of spray mount about a foot away from your artwork
4. Spray an even coating of adhesive over the back of the artwork



STEP TWO: Place artwork on foam core

1. Flip your work over in your hands and gingerly place it on the foam core, towards an edge to conserve the board
2. Smooth the work out gently, making sure to get all air bubbles out from under the artwork
3. Let the adhesive dry for a few minutes



STEP THREE: Trim your artwork out of foam core

1. Place the board with the artwork face up on a suitable cutting surface
2. Using your ruler, find the edge of the artwork
3. Carefully, use your X-Acto knife to cut the initial slice.
4. Go over that initial slice with increasing pressure until you have sliced entirely through the foam core
5. Repeat on each edge of the artwork until you can pop it out of the foamcore with no effort
