
Mounting Your Artwork


Supplies Needed

- 1 Sheet black foam core, 1/4 inch thick
- Spray mount
- X-acto knife with some fresh blades
- Metal ruler, cork-backed to keep from slipping
- · A copy of your artwork
- · Some newspaper




STEP ONE: Spray adhesive on artwork

- Lay some newspaper down on the ground to protect your artwork
- 2. Lay your artwork on the newspaper face down
- 3. Hold the can of spray mount about a foot away from your artwork
- 4. Spray an even coating of adhesive over the back of the artwork



STEP TWO: Place artwork on foam core

- Flip your work over in your hands and gingerly place it on the foam core, towards an edge to conserve the board
- 2. Smooth the work out gently, making sure to get all air bubbles out from under the artwork
- 3. Let the adhesive dry for a few minutes



STEP THREE: Trim your artwork out of foam core

- 1. Place the board with the artwork face up on a suitable cutting surface
- 2. Using your ruler, find the edge of the artwork
- 3. Carefully, use your X-Acto knife to cut the initial slice.
- 4. Go over that initial slice with increasing pressure until you have sliced entirely through the foam core
- 5. Repeat on each edge of the artwork until you can pop it out of the foamcore with no effort
