Major Responsibilities

- Manage consulting architects and engineers to produce high quality designs.
- Produce designs that result in elegant, efficiently constructed and durable buildings.
- Manage all phases of project development from scope definition through construction administration.
- Ensure assigned projects meet approved budgets and schedules.
- Develop construction estimates and project schedules for supervisor's approval.
- Ensure all projects meet or exceed Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements, NYC Building Code requirements and other applicable regulations.
- Develop "green" or sustainable design elements to implement into project work.
- Review designs with agency staff including engineers, landscape architects, engineers, construction staff and maintenance personnel.
- Present projects to other governmental agencies and departments, contractors and their representatives, consultants, community members and the general public, as required.

Qualification Requirements

- A baccalaureate degree in architecture from an accredited college and two (2) years of full-time experience in planning, design, research, investigations and/or studies related to urban design development programs; or
- Education and/or experience which is equivalent to "1" above. However, a baccalaureate degree in architecture is required of all candidates. Graduate work leading to an advanced degree in architecture, urban design or city planning may be substituted for experience on a year-for-year basis.

Residency in New York City, Nassau, Orange, Rockland, Suffolk, Putnam, or Westchester counties required for employees with over two years of city service. New York City residency required within 90 days of hire for all other candidates.
