## **Legislative Committee Meeting Minutes**

1. The meeting was called to order at 1:00 pm

- 2. Randall Hannum was in attendance to oversee nomination and election of Legislative Committee chair
  - Prof. Swift nominated and elected as Chair unanimously.
  - Prof. Cheng nominated and elected as Secretary unanimously.
- 3. General discussion of what issues Legislative could address for 2019-2020 year, including
  - Prof. Swift raised issue of timing of elections for department delegates (with Chair elections), which does not permit newly elected delegates to serve on Committee for Committees. Discussion tabled.
  - Prof. Hannum raised the issue of lack of full membership to Personnel Appeals
     Committee: timing of elections and language in governance may be discouraging
     participation. It was agreed that this issue would be taken up this term.
  - Prof. Katz asked about status of proposals from Profs. Katz and Catapano from previous year. It was reported that those proposals were never engaged by Legislative.
  - Strategies to increase Faculty participation in college-wide elections.
  - Prof. Katz requested that the committee consider evaluating of the process of hiring of senior-level administrative positions in order to
    - increase faculty participation;
    - o increase transparency (via open hearings, for instance);
    - o clarify procedures for hiring senior-level administrators;
    - o take into consideration the evaluation process from the student point of view; and
    - o understand the basis by which applicants to these positions are evaluated.

The committee agreed to take up this issue in the current term.

- 4. Prof. Swift asked that all standing committee minutes be posted on the OpenLab and made available to the public in a timely manner. Prof. Hannum confirmed that this is the goal.
- 5. Prof. Swift asked the committee to take up the electronic ballot counting measure that was not completed last term. Discussion tabled.
- 6. Prof. Swift asked committee members to bring issues to the committee that they believe need addressing.
- 7. Prof. Donsky volunteered to handle attendance sheets for College Council General Meetings
- 8. Volunteers will be sought for upcoming Appointments Committee elections in several departments
- 9. Prof. Archer volunteered to oversee the English Dept's Appointments Committee elections
- 10. The meeting adjourned at 2:10 pm
