The UFS passed a resolution to fully fund negotiated contracts, Excelsior Scholarships, and various other items. City Tech student/SGA President Tim Hunter was recognized for his efforts in advocating for funding the University.
  - b. UFS representative Lubie Grujicic-Alatrisme discussed passing a UFS resolution and creating a task force to observe sufficient support for funding and agency for policy changes related to developmental education reform.
  - c. Professors expressed concern about educational access for students who experience economic insecurity.

- a. The Provost announced that the City Tech Bachelor of Architecture program has been registered with the State of New York. The Provost recognized the chair of the Architecture Technology Department for their work on this project.
  - b. The Provost announced that Janet Liou-Mark is the interim director of the Faculty Commons.
  - c. The Provost announced that the COACHE task force has been meeting to address the concerns expressed in the COACHE survey.
  - d. The Provost announced a Title V application to develop meta majors to support student retention and graduation, utilize electronic tools for advisement, and the use of “smart” tools to strengthen the institution.
  - e. The ePARSE will be due in June. There is support available for faculty to use the system.
