Meeting minutes for February 2,2021 were approved by the committee.

#### Budget

Budget is provided by CUNY to individual colleges month to month.

## **Enrollment**

Drop in enrollment created \$156 million in losses for CUNY. Community colleges are down approximately 20%, and senior colleges 17.6%.

## **CUNY**

CUNY - Spring 2021 revenues are \$40.4 million less than in Spring 2020.

## **Current State of CityTech**

In the past City Tech enrolled about 18k students, in spring 2021 enrollment dropped to about 13k students.

This represents loss of approximately \$5 million in revenues.

Middle States approved our online classes.

# **Union & Chancellor**

The Union and Chancellor met to discuss salary increases for certain titles.

Contractual obligations are picked by the state and city.

#### FTES

We need to replace faculty who are retiring or leaving for another job. CUNY continues to freeze hiring of new faculty.

#### Recruitment

It was successful in the past when potential stud nets and their parents were able to visit in person. New strategies are emerging.

## **Projects**

The Jay street entrance will be accessible for disabled.

Cold Spring Harbor refurbishing of 2<sup>nd</sup> floor in Pearl building will be completed very soon.
