- Minutes of November 8, 2022 were approved unanimously
- The committee introduced themselves to the student guests
- Staff Technology Survey Questions
 - How long should we have it be active? About a month after approval by Executive
 - o Expectation we'll report highlights by end of semester
 - We'll approach in a similar manner as the faculty survey
 - MB: how many people are getting the survey and what percentage of response will be adequate
 - RA: not a lot of dialogue about the last survey during Council, some comments
 afterwards; MB: consider sharing results before Council so participants can ask more
 questions
 - o AG: redundancies?
 - MB: required questions? Concerns about creating the survey, survey taker fatigue
 - The committee unanimously voted to approve the survey with the understanding there may be some minor tweaking
 - o MB: Split the question into two for academic support vs other support—it's OK as is
 - AG: we need to ask if technology is integral to the individual's work, what technologies do they use? This was not entirely resolved but
 - AG: her HEO will test drive the survey and consider whether or not it reflects the hybrid work environment in the questions so we can do some final tweaks
- College Council website presence on main college website
 - o MB, AG will co-chair with BI collaborating
 - MB: Just link out to OpenLab, possibly add a calendar (not a list of dates)
 - o MB: current architecture on OpenLab is excellent
 - o AG: Splash page similar to Registrar
 - We'll start by looking at John Jay, Hunter, and Brooklyn College's sites
