**1. Call to Order:**

**2. Approval of Minutes:**

- a. N. Katz moved to include CLT and HEO delegate elections along with the normally scheduled spring 2024 department chair/delegate elections. The motion passed.

- b. N. Katz moved to have the recent (10/17/23) Nursing DAC election rerun due to objections raised by a majority of voting members of the department regarding how the original election was run. The motion passed.

- c. N. Katz introduced a resolution regarding how Article VII, Section B(1) of the Constitution of the College Council of New York City College of Technology should be interpreted when a member of the Library has been elected to the Academic Integrity Committee. This resolution passed.
  - Vote: 5 in favor, 0 opposed, 0 abstained.
