Some common uses and problems with alignment

FL/RR [Flushed left- Ragged Right] is the most common kind. Often used for heavy text. Good for columns with short line length

One day her mother said to her: ‘Come, Little Red-Cap, here is a piece of cake and a bottle of wine; take them to your grandmother, she is ill and weak, and they will do her good. Be careful with odd line breaks, multiple hyphens (ladders)

FR/RL [Flushed Right- Ragged Left]

Used for minimal text scenario. Quotes, Breaks.

Used for minimal text scenario.

Rhythm of lines: Careful with short /long/short/long

Widows/orphans/hyphenated word

Start of a Paragraph?

J [Justified]

Often used for heavy text. Better when the line length is longer (wider column)

Control of hyphens and rhythm of text lines can be very tricky

FJ [Forced Justification]

When to use? Rarely-- Highly problematic

Rivers! Rivers! Rivers! Odd spaces between words and letters
