



HOMEWORK 2 | Due Week 4 4-panel Comic Strip

Objective:

Write and draw a traditional 4-panel comic strip.

Process:

Begin by sketching thumbnails & writing ideas for 4-panel comic strips. Don't worry about being funny and drawn loosely but legible enough that they can be understood: you will clean them up for the final.

Week 1:

- In your sketchbook you should draw one 4-panel comic strip each day, so you will have at least six ideas by next week.
- Aim for graphic simplicity, clarity, and consistency.
- Use 4-panels for each strip, with each panel being equal size.

Week 2:

- Peer critique to select your final idea
- Edit based on feedback, sketch more versions
- Pencil to Ink Final 4-panel strip

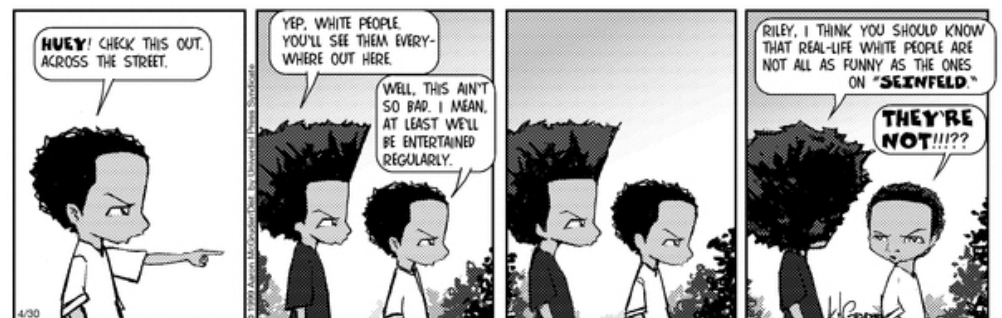
Requirements:
