Objective:

Create a fictional Short Story in the format of a mini comic featuring your original character or characters!

Description:

As we learned while working on our midterm, coming up with ideas is not as hard as figuring out how to get those ideas on the page. The story you tell can be as simple or complex as you want to make it.



You may choose to use a story you sparked by today's in class activities- or an entirely new one.

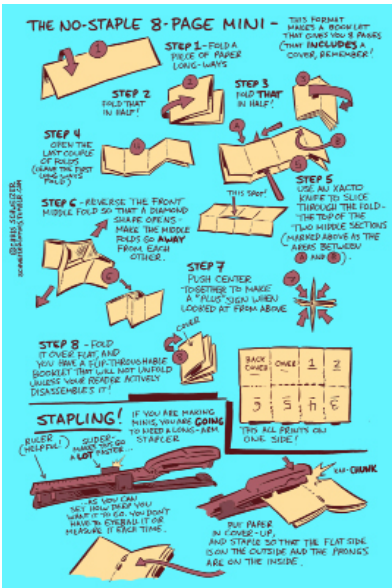
Requirements:

The comic needs to be 8 pages.

SCALE:

The 8 pages can be 5.5"x8.5" or a folded one sheet: 4.25"x5.5"

- You can work digitally or traditionally.
- You will print or reproduce your work.
- You will fold and, if necessary, staple your comics.
- Make an edition of at least 15 comics. (Print more if you want to have more to distribute on your own!)
- You must write a script of some sort



Timeline:

- 3/31 Final Assigned.
HW - 6 Short Story Blurbs, begin sketching characters / world
- 4/7 Bring Short Story Blurbs, and sketches.
HW - Outline script, continue sketching visuals.
- 4/14 Bring script to class to discuss. Edits will be suggested.
HW - Edit script, decide format, begin page/panel breakdowns.
- 4/28 Bring edited script. Bring page/panel breakdowns
HW - finish page/panel breakdowns, begin final pencils.
- 5/5 Bring final breakdowns and beginning pencils.
HW - Finish pencils, begin inks.
- 5/12 Bring Work In Progress. Test printing and folding and stapling.
HW - FINISH EVERYTHING. Print, fold
