3 cl hours, 120 field hours/semester

#### Writing Intensive

(BFA degree) Assignment to fieldwork/study situations of approximately eight to ten hours per week at an internship site approved by the department Internship Coordinator: an advertising agency, graphic design firm, corporate design office, publications art department, photography or illustration studio, TV or media production company. Each student keeps a blog/journal to be shared in group seminars. Supervision is by faculty and by the supervisor at the internship site. The class is a hybrid class. Internships may be undertaken during the spring, summer and fall semesters.

Prerequisites: COMD 3701 or COMD 4701 or department approval. Course offered spring, summer and fall semesters
