#### Benefits of DegreeWorks

- When using DegreeWorks, students will be able to:
  - > View all requirements for your degree
  - ➤ View how completed and in-progress courses apply to your degree requirements
  - ➤ Identify courses needed to complete your degree
  - View your overall GPA
- Important note: After your registration, you should check if any course(s) is (are) under "Fallthrough courses" or "Elective classes *not* allowed" on the bottom of your DegreeWorks.

#### Important note of DegreeWorks

- After your registration, you should check if any course(s) is (are) under "Fallthrough courses" or "Elective classes not allowed" on the bottom of your DegreeWorks.
- If so, it indicates that your registration might be **out of CET Curriculum** and causes your **financial aid (TAP) problem**.
- You should get an academic advisement with your faculty advisor as soon as possible.

### Writing Intensive (WI) Courses

- Must complete 4 WI Courses in total for your graduation.
- 2 courses designated WI for the associate level, one from GenEd and one from the EMT major
  - EMT 1255, PHYS 1433/1441
- 2 additional courses designated WI for the baccalaureate level, one from GenEd and one from the CET major.
  - > CET 4773, PHYS 1434/1442
- So you can complete WI courses if you finish all EMT and CET curriculum.

### Interdisciplinary (ID) Courses

- Must take one Interdisciplinary (ID) Course for your graduation.
- All ID courses have the course code followed by ID such as HIS 3402ID and PHIL 2202ID, but HIS 3402 and PHIL 2202 are not ID courses even though they have the same code numbers.
- Please find an ID course from the link below and check a list by semester, of sections that qualify.
