CPLR § 503: "Venue based on residence. (a) Generally. Except where otherwise prescribed by law, the place of trial shall be in the county in which one of the parties resided when it was commenced; [OR] the county in which a substantial part of the events or omissions giving rise to the claim occurred; [OR], if none of the parties then resided in the state, in any county designated by the plaintiff. . . ."

Options:

- Where one of the parties resided when commenced
- Where the events occurred (where it happened)
- If neither party lives in NY—any county plaintiff chooses

Chantal, a resident of Westchester County (in NY), wants to sue Michael, a resident of Suffolk County (in NY), for a tort Michael allegedly committed in Albany County (in NY). It did NOT involve a consumer credit transaction. What venue is proper under CPLR § 503(a)?
