

Assignment in lieu of class 17 (April 1, 2019): Papers Prepared for Filing and Service

This submission counts for your attendance in class 17, and as an assignment.

Part A: In complete sentences, explain each of the following terms, as they are used in chapter 11:

1. caption
2. affidavit
3. *pro se*
4. non-parties

NOTE: Not all of these terms are defined in the chapter! (such as "caption") If you do not find a definition in the chapter, you should research it elsewhere, such as a legal dictionary or other outside source. You are also welcome, and encouraged, to make your best, educated effort to explain what you think it means from the context (what you read and saw in the chapter) and from your own knowledge and experience. What is most important is that you provide an explanation that matches how the term is used in the chapter! (For example, "caption" has many meanings.) Do not just quote a definition from a legal dictionary or other source without confirming that it suits the word as used in the chapter. Please cite the source(s) of your responses, whether they are the chapter itself, or outside sources, or your own brain.

Part B: Answer "Do You Get It?" questions #1-8 on pp. 98C-98D of chapter 11. For each, please restate the question, then answer it in complete sentences that incorporate the question. For example: "1. What are the contents of a caption? The contents of a caption are"
