From People v. Neulander, 34 N.Y.3d 110, 112 (2019):

"Issue: Whether the undisputed juror misconduct in this case warrants a reversal of the judgment convicting Dr. Neulander of murder and evidence tampering?"

Compare--from sample brief, in brief-writer's own words:

Issue: Whether juror's sending and receiving hundreds of text messages, accessing extensive internet coverage during trial, then lying to the court and People about it, warrants reversal of murder conviction?
