Corsello v. Verizon New York Inc., 25 Misc.3d 122 (Sup. Ct. Kings County 2009).

Statute = law created by legislative branch of a government (U.S. Congress or state legislature)

Organized into **statutory compilations:**

- Federal = "United States Code" (U.S.C.) → **official!**
Unofficial:
 - United States Code Annotated (U.S.C.A.) (published by West)
 - United States Code Service (U.S.C.S.) (published by LexisNexis)
- New York = "Consolidated Laws of New York" → **official!**
Unofficial:
 - McKinney's Consolidated Laws of New York (West) ("McKinney's")
 - New York Consolidated Laws Service (LexisNexis)
