Discuss your findings of normal and abnormal. Maintain proper operator/patient positioning, adequate lighting, and asepsis throughout the entire competency.

Visually inspects and palpates the floor of the mouth

Wraps extended tongue in damp gauze & visually inspects: dorsal, ventral, lateral surfaces (using mouth mirror) & palpates the tongue

Visually inspects the alveolar ridges, maxillary tuberosities (palpates also) & retromolar pads (palpates also); using mouth mirror as needed
