

## Lesson Plan for Clinical Session #14

This session we are introducing new instrument– **Universal Curet.**

### **Learning objectives:**

- Briefly discuss subgingival calculus deposits.
- Identify parts of the universal curet.
- Introduce applications of universal curet (supra, sub, anterior, posterior)
- Introduce selection of correct working end and instrumentation sequence for anterior and posterior teeth.
- Introduce calculus removal concepts – insertion, angulation, adaptation, 3 types of pressure, calculus removal stroke, stroke activation.

At the beginning of the session gather students in room A-713 for the presentation of the new instrument. **Please allow up to an hour for this presentation.**

1. Review PowerPoint on Universal Curets.
2. Please discuss calculus removal stroke, insertion, adaptation, and angulation.
3. Briefly mention sharpening – just what pertains to this instrument – semi-circular in cross section, has a toe and two cutting edges, both cutting edges must be sharpened (toe-third, middle-third, and heel-third)
4. Break into small groups for hands-on presentation on the Typodont.
5. The rest of the clinic time will be dedicated to students working with the new instruments on each other (divide remaining time evenly between partners).
