When thinking of how my interview went I had to look back and think about how well I prepared. I first made sure to read through my cover letter and resume to make sure I remember what I had written down. I printed extra copies to give each of the interviewers. Afterwards I asked to sit down, I was pretty confident about my research, to openly talk about the store and of the position.

I was asked several questions but prepared to answer any question. I was asked how I heard of the position to which I answered truthfully, and explained how much I actually loved the store. I was asked of what I expected my responsibilities would be to which I referred to the website and past experiences working at other retail stores. I was asked specifically about my current position working at S&T and my responsibilities. I explained that I had only begun working there in January, but that I've had a great relationship with everyone I worked with. We then went on to talk about a "what if" situation.

I was asked "what if a sale with a customer had gotten out of hand?" to which I answered that I've had experiences with sales that have gotten out of hand and explained that when I worked at Sneaker Town I had an experience where a customer would argue about a price with me. I explained to the customer that the price was not set by me therefore I personally couldn't change it. The customer then went on to argue that I was wrong and that my manager would charge him less, since my manager wasn't there then I gave the customer a business card telling him to call back later when hopefully a manager would help him and apologized for not being able to assist him. I explained that I was able to handle the situation without it escalating and getting out of hand. I was then asked of my weaknesses and explained that my weaknesses may actually help the store.

I explained how I only learn well if I'm interested in the products which I am. I also explained that I over think things, which make me, double-check everything important. Overall I think I did a good job and I had fun with this challenge.
