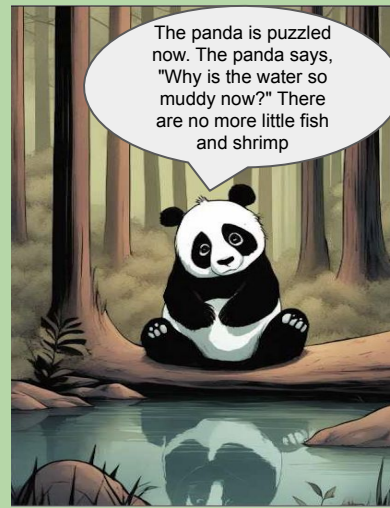


Protect animals for a sustainable future
