Your presentation should explain the issue presented in the news article, and the relationship it has to the manifesto you selected. Please use at least one specific example. If you choose your own manifesto, you should also briefly describe it to the class. (I am happy to provide copies of your manifesto for the class, if you would like.)

You must hand in a copy of the article you choose, as well as a short paragraph explaining the connection you see the between the manifesto and article.

Your proposal and essay must be typed, in MLA format (double-spaced, 12pt, Times New Roman font, 1-inch margins), with proper MLA citations.

Your name, my name, the course, the due date, and the assignment name should all be at the top left of the page. NO COVER PAGE.
