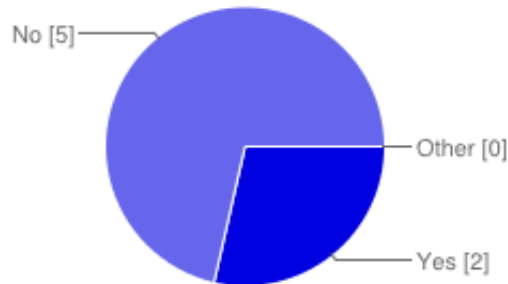

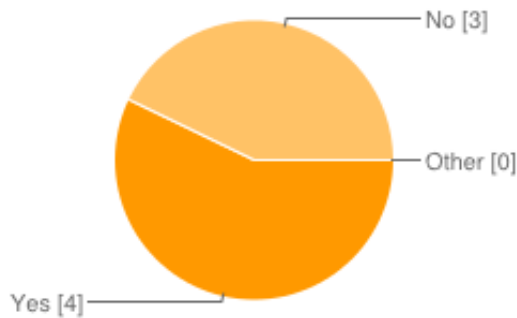

**Was the theme assignment required?**



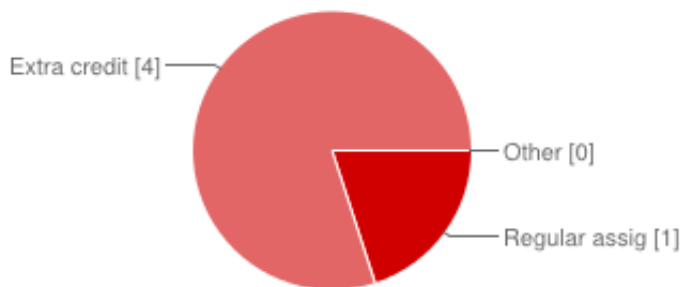

**Was the theme assignment graded?**



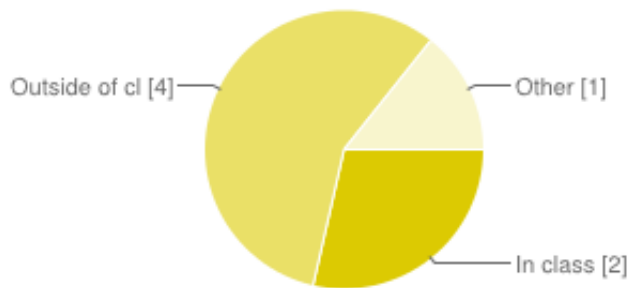

**If graded, was it part of regular coursework or did it earn extra credit?**



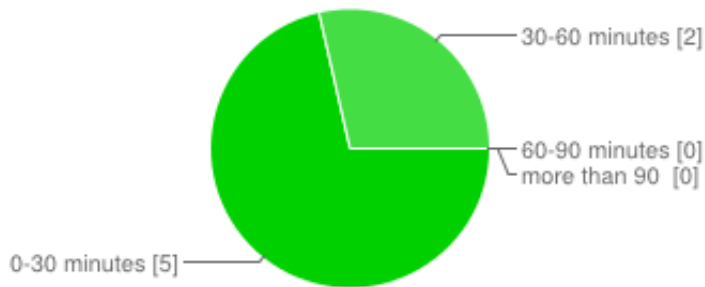

### How much cumulative time did you spend discussing the assignment in class?



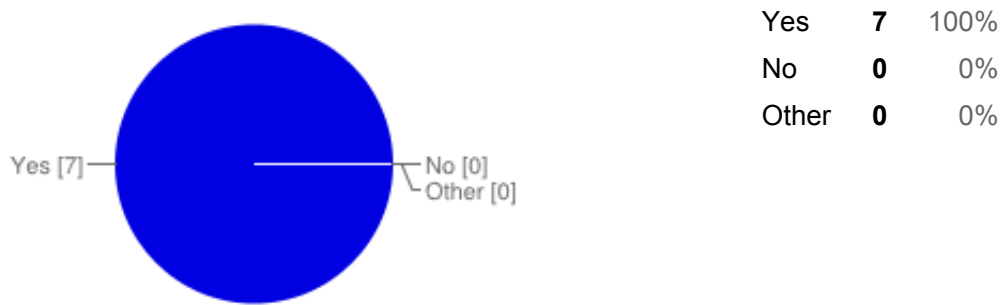

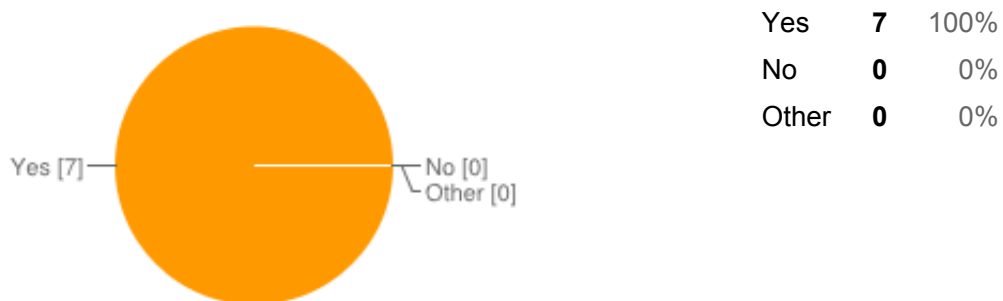
