# Transparency Effect: Opacity for a color image in InDesign

\* Note: There are multiple ways of achieving this effect.

## Go to InDesign and place the image

**Go to WINDOWS> EFFECT** and change **Opacity** 




Image will stay in color, but appears lighter




This might be helpful if you need to maintain the look of the image, but have to think about contrast between typography & background
