- 4. According to Chenjerai Kumanyika what role did the federal and state government have in making local police departments look more like the US military than what they are supposed to be?
- 5. Do you agree with Chenjerai Kumanyika's criticism of how policing is conducted in America? Explain why you agree or disagree with him.
