align ruler to edge > cut

1

Finalize your letterform.

Create a **reverse** (if your letter was white on a black surface, create a black letter on white. see *figure A*)

2

Open a **new Indesign** document: 8.5 x 11 in margins: 12 pt
In the top left corner of your page add your first letterform
Make it a 3 in. square Do NOT outline

Open **step and repeat**: Edit > Step and Repeat see *figure B*
rows: 3, columns: 2, check "create a grid"
vertical: 3 in., horizontal: 3 in

You will have a grid of 6 units of your letterform see *figure C*

Click: OK

3

Open a **second page and repeat step 2** with your reverse letterform

Print **3 copies of each page**, 6 copies total

5

Align your **ruler** on the edge of a row. **Trim** with your xacto knife
Continue to cut all pages. You will have **18 squares of EACH** letter

6

Bring all squares to Thursday's class

In class, we will arrange squares in a grid of 16, 4 across, 4 down

We will align our forms to create larger areas, **NOT patterns**

We will review this process in class
