Area  
Between the cold zone and the subtropical zone (40° to 60°)

Sun path  
Maximum 73°, minimum 0° (at Arctic Circle)

Average temperature  
Between 0 and 20°C

Minimal temperature  
-40°C

Maximal temperature  
+40°C

Radiation  
The balance is negative

Daylength  
4 to 16 hours  
8 to 12 hours at 50°N

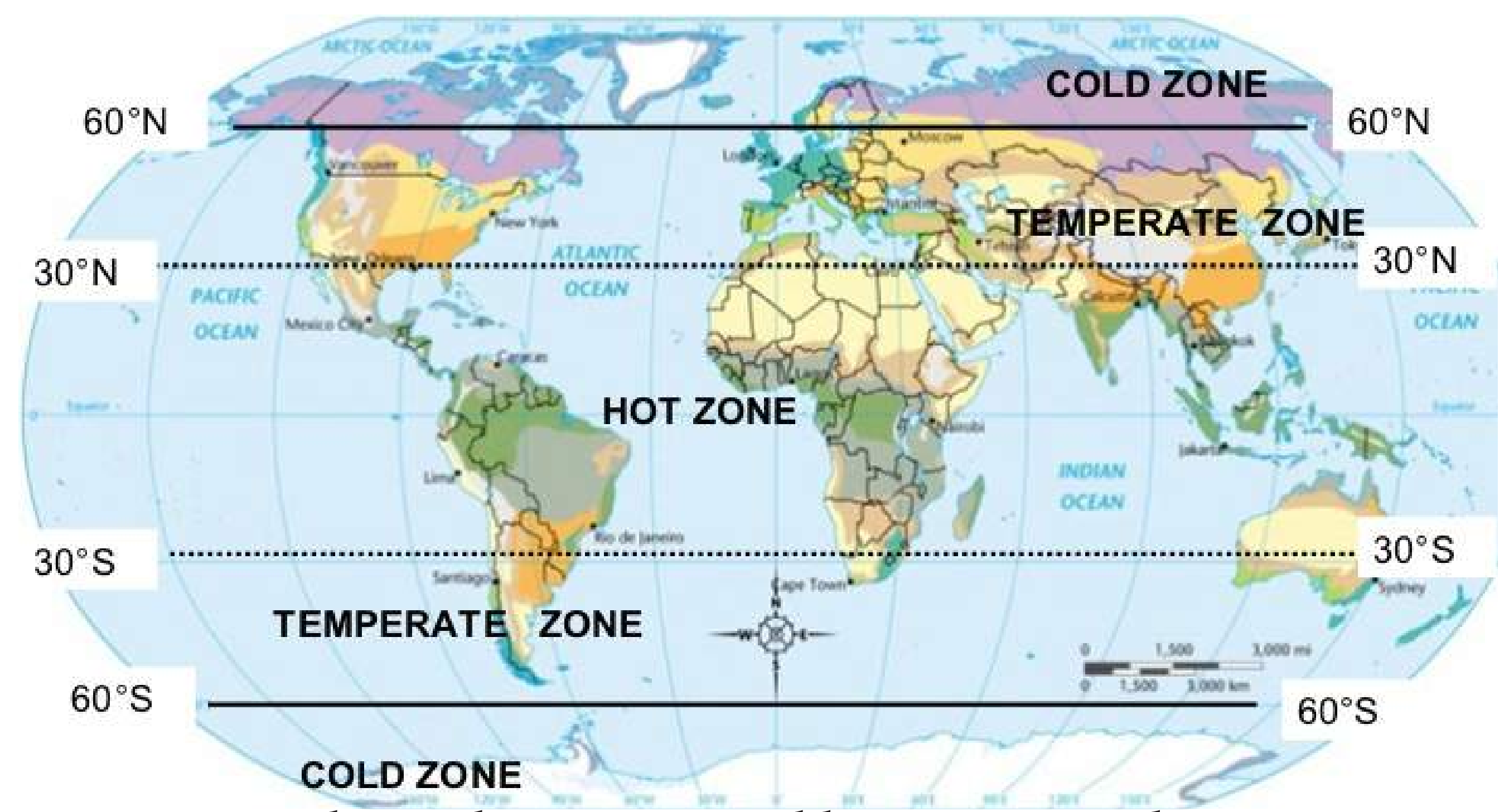
Precipitation  
From 300 to 2000 mm, average 800 mm

Climate  
Warm and cold temperate

Vegetation  
Deciduous forests, warm temperate forests, savannah

Properties  
Extreme temperature and precipitation is rare

# TEMPERATE



A temperate climate has very noticeable seasons, windy, non-excessive temperatures, and in high altitudes such as mountains, there is colder weather all year.
