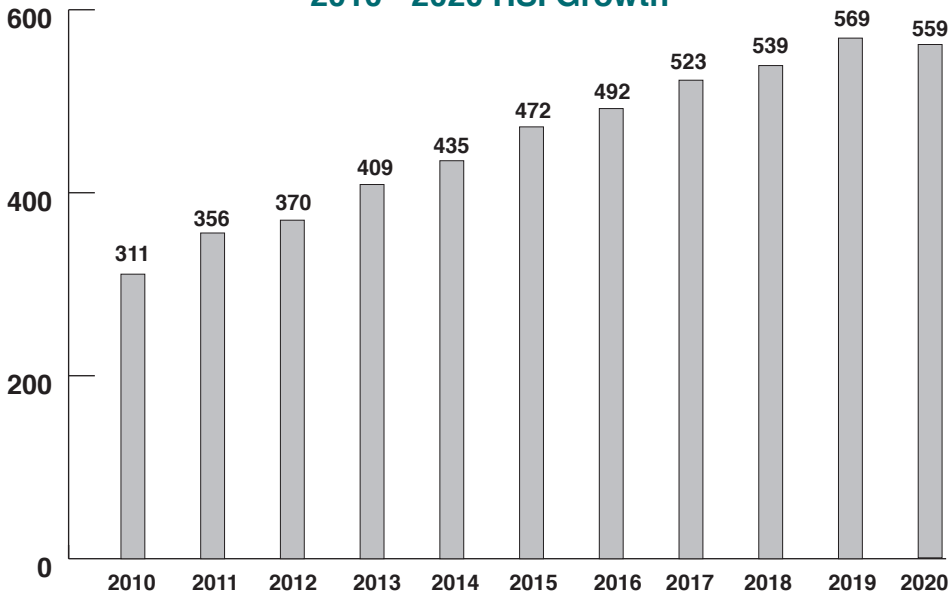

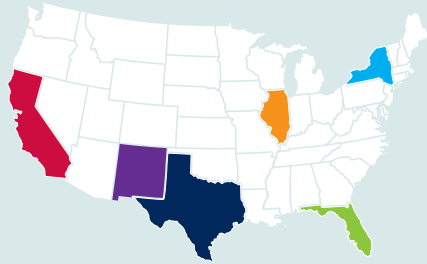

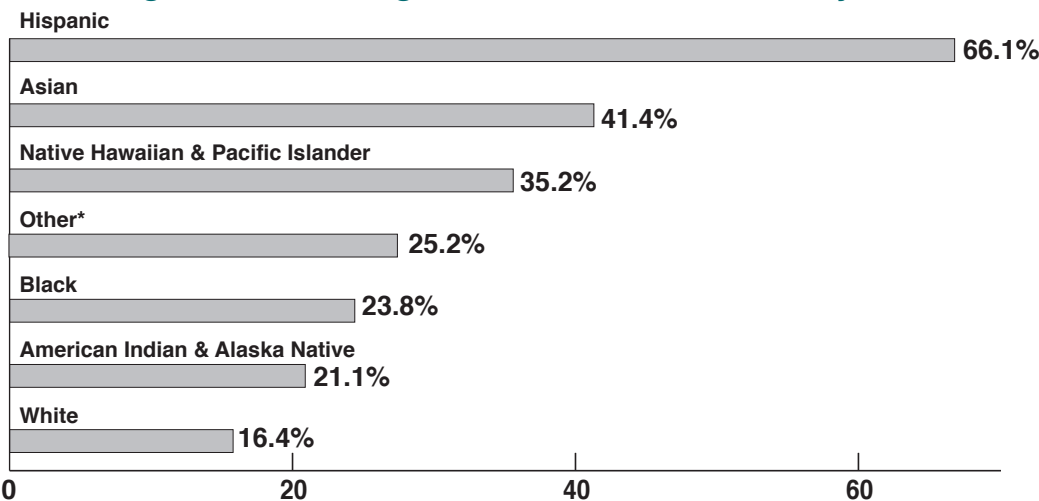

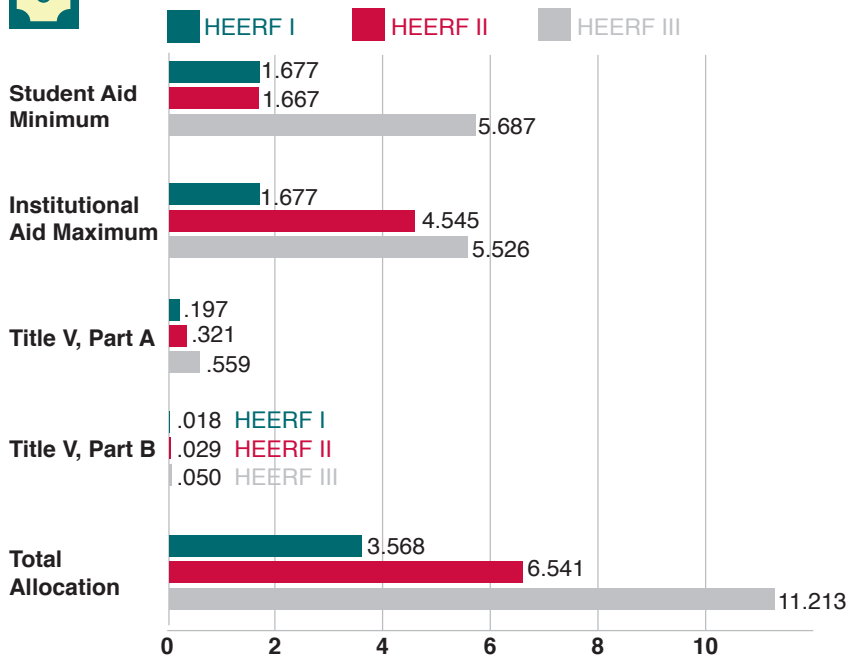

HSI Higher Emergency Relief* (HEERF) Funds in Billions

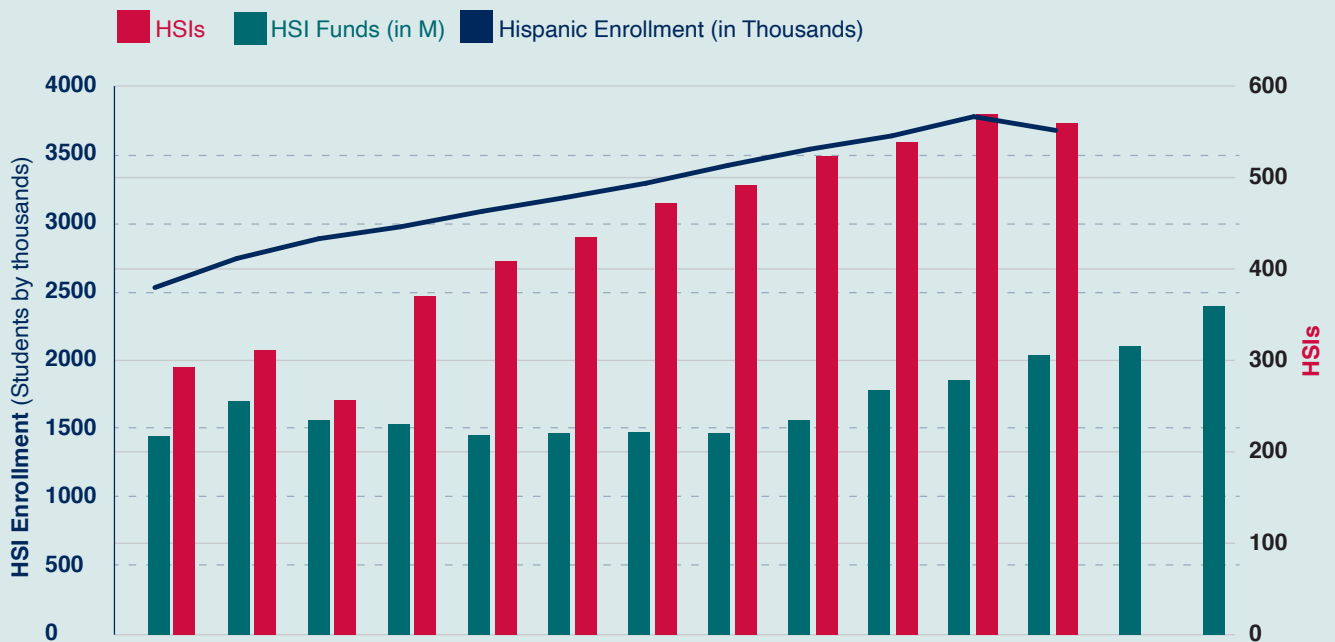
